Zimbabwe Experience

- 1996 Telephone Users Association / ZIMTEL Conferences: *The CCZ umbrella - build on what is there*
- 2000 Liberalisation: PTC Act establishes Regulator POTRAZ: Act's mandate leads POTRAZ to assume it is the Consumer – be wary of what you create.
- 2000 2009 : Environmental turbulence
 Scope for consumer advocacy severely limited there are other games
- 2010 2016 : Quest for operator viability dominates
 Despite network cost analysis and modelling, consumers saddled with high tariff regime and sidelining. "Floor Prices" the show goes on nonetheless
- SADC accommodates lobby for regional consumer association: ISIT/GoZ MoU, ISIT on SAIGF MCT, SADC Secretariat on SCOM agenda – unity has its strengths



"Towards a Peaceful, Prosperous & Integrated Africa"

- African consumers need to engage the AU as a united non-state coalition or association of active partners.
- African Union top-down or bottom-up? There is a case for subregional bodies: SADC, ECOWAS, E
- Developing institutional capacity and activities beyond passionate individuals
