Abraão Balbino e Silva is Network Engineer, Core Network Expert and Master's in economics and management. Until 2022 he was Anatel's Competition Superintendent and deputy member of the Agency's Board of Commissioners, being the high-ranked technical authority responsible for the economic regulation of the telecommunications sector in Brazil, including competition policy, prices, costs, and the monitoring of the economic issues involved. He recently coordinated the works of the Brazilian 5G Auction that took place in 2021. He is

currently the Executive Superintendent of the Agency, managing and coordinating all internal areas and corresponding interface with the Chairman and the Board of Commissioners, as well as with other governmental bodies. In the international field, he represents Brazil in ITU for 15 years. In that organization, since 2014 he is vice-chairman of ITU-T Study Group 3, and chairman of WP2/3 which is responsible for international telecommunications policy and regulatory issues. He was rapporteur of various important topics such as international roaming, OTTs, and competition policy. He is the author of books and academic articles related to the sector. He has been a career employee at Anatel since 2007. Before joining the federal public service, he worked in the engineering and marketing areas of companies in the telecommunications sector.
