- Established in 1997 in cooperation between APT and ITU Regional Office for Asia and the Pacific
- Discuss and coordinate all the issues relating to regulations in telecommunications and ICT which are of common interest to the telecommunication regulators of South Asian countries
- SATRC activities are conducted by involvement of the highest level representations by the regulatory bodies of the South Asian countries

  - SATRC Workshop on Policy, Regulation and Services
- **SATRC Web Portal:** collect information from regulatory bodies and publish on SATRC webpage for information sharing
