# Introduction

- Measuring Universal and Meaningful Connectivity



2018-2019

- UN Secretary-General convenes a **High-level Panel on Digital Cooperation** which drafts the report “**The age of digital interdependence**”.

2020

- Based on the Panel’s report and following further multistakeholder consultations, the Secretary-General issued his report **Roadmap for Digital Cooperation**, which includes, at its core, a **commitment to “connect” all people to the Internet**.

2021

- multistakeholder **Roundtable on Global Connectivity**, co-chaired by the United Nations Children's Fund (**UNICEF**) and **ITU**, with the support of the Office of the Secretary-General’s Envoy on Technology (**OSET**), works to **follow up on the Roadmap** by implementing its recommendations.

2022

- The OSET and ITU announced a new set of **UN targets for universal and meaningful digital connectivity** to be achieved by 2030.

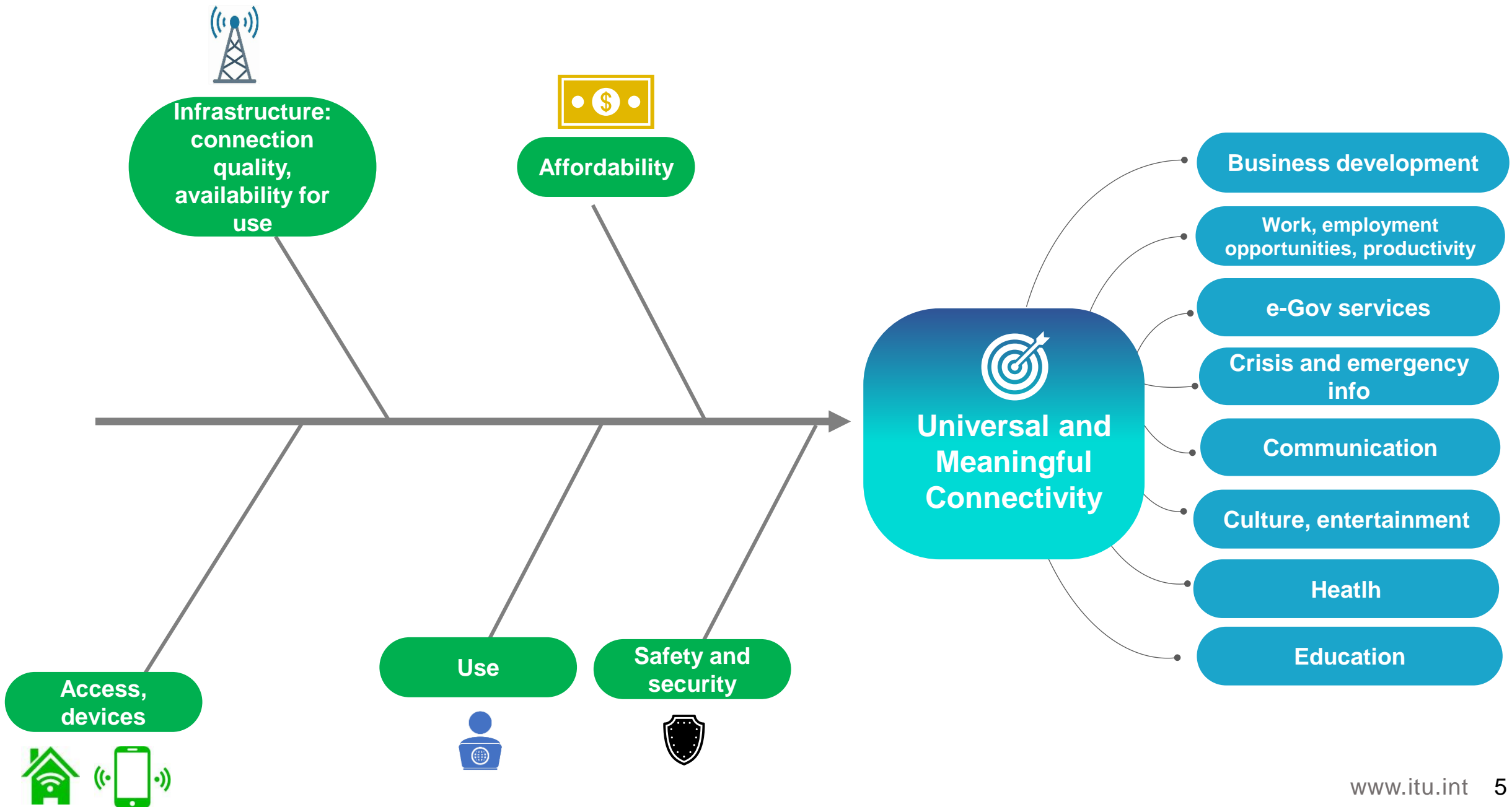
2024

- UN General Assembly adopts the Pact for the Future and **Global Digital Compact**

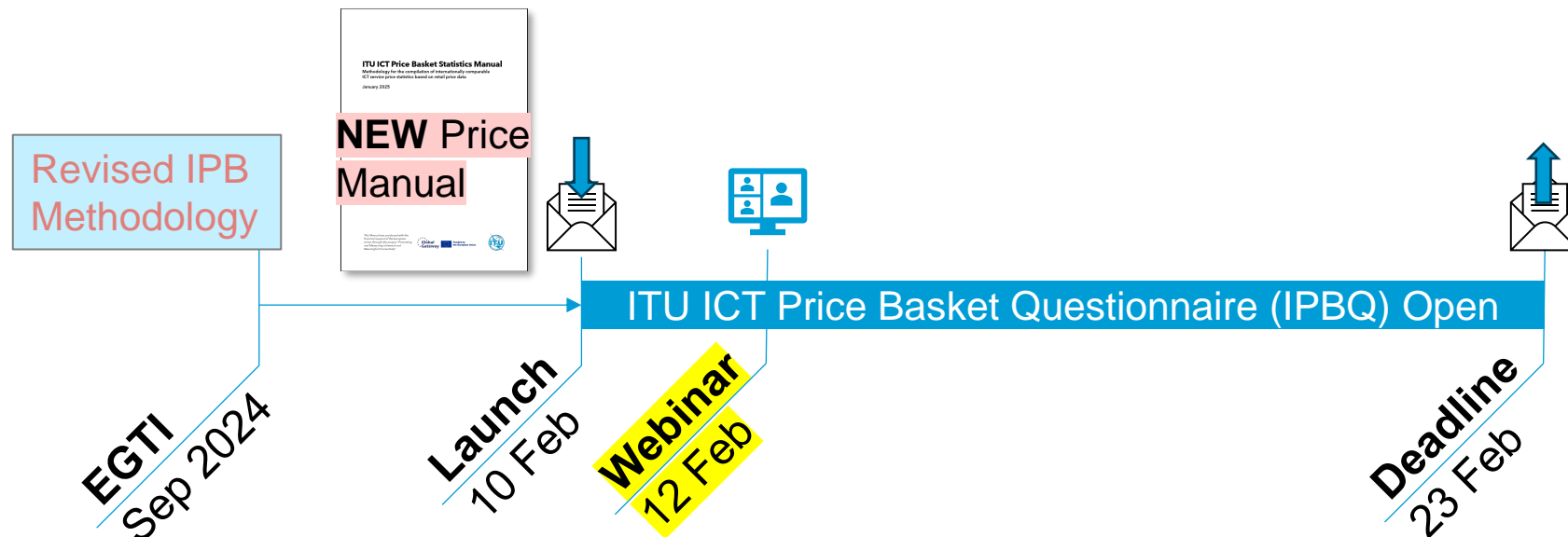

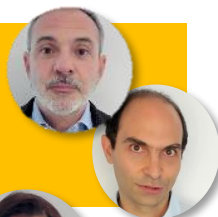

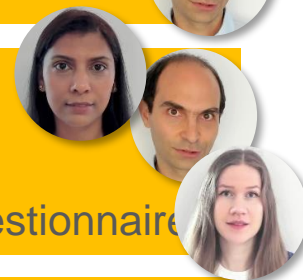

# **ITU ICT Price Baskets: Concept & data collection**



## The basics:

- What Are ICT Price Basket Statistics?
  - A standardized methodology developed by ITU to measure and compare the affordability of ICT services worldwide.
  - These statistics aggregate service prices into predefined "baskets".
  - They provide a benchmark for policymakers to assess affordability and digital inclusion progress.
- Why Are They Important?
  - Comparability: Enables cross-country analysis of ICT service affordability.
  - Policy Guidance: Helps governments set affordability targets and monitor progress toward Universal and Meaningful Connectivity.
  - Market Transparency: Provides insights into pricing trends in ICT markets.
- What Do the ICT Price Baskets Measure?
  - Mobile and Fixed Broadband.
  - Mobile Voice & SMS & Data Bundles.

# How to make ICT prices internationally comparable?



## Unit = Basket

A **basket of ICT services** is the internationally comparable unit



## Data collection rules

Retail prices collected based on the rules agreed by the ITU Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI)



## 5 baskets

Representative for services used in high- and low-income countries



## Quality assurance

Data collected by country focal points and desk research, and validated

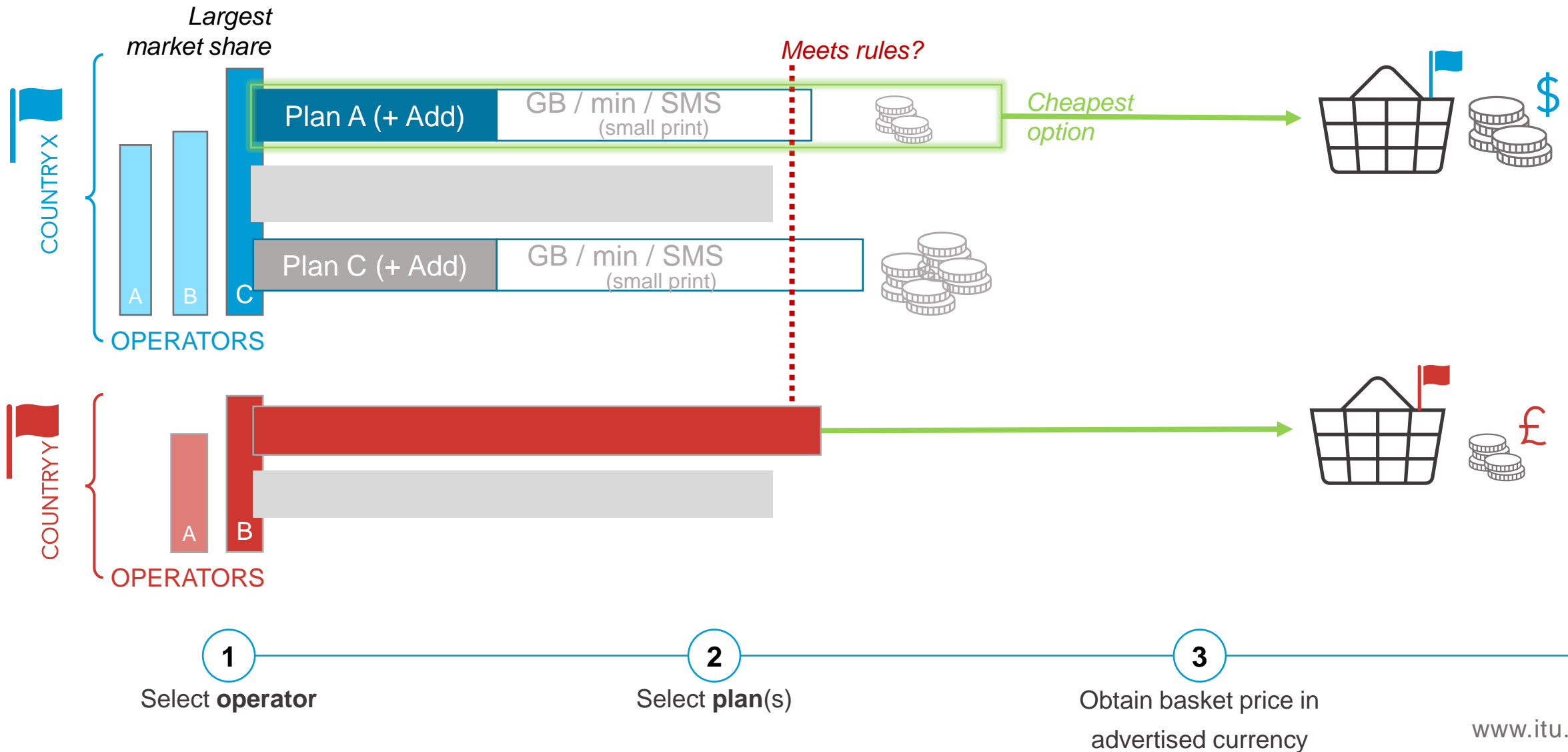


## 3 units

Prices collected in advertised currencies converted to 3 units of measurement (USD, PPP, GNI per capita)

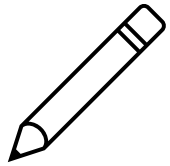

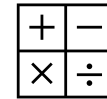

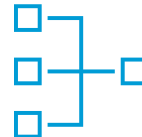

- ITU Verify questions with data submitters



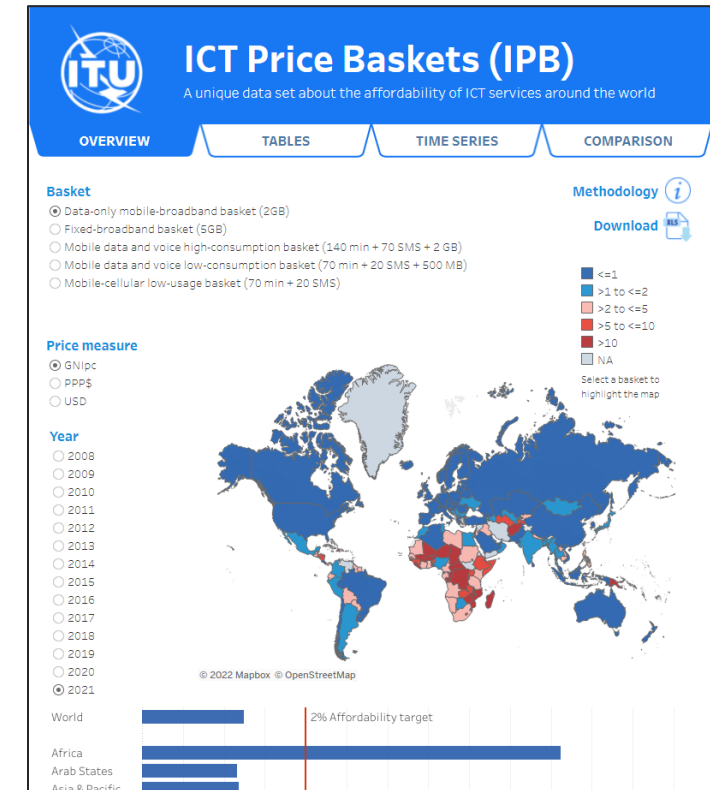
## USD, PPP, % GNI per capita

- **Collect exchange rates** data from the World Bank, IMF, UN OPS; (USD: Q1; GNI, PPP: last year)
- **Convert** basket prices to comparable measurement units



## Dissemination

- Publish data on **IPB web application** on ITU website
- Compute and publish country group **medians** and **historical time series** (excel tables)
- Use data for further **analyses**

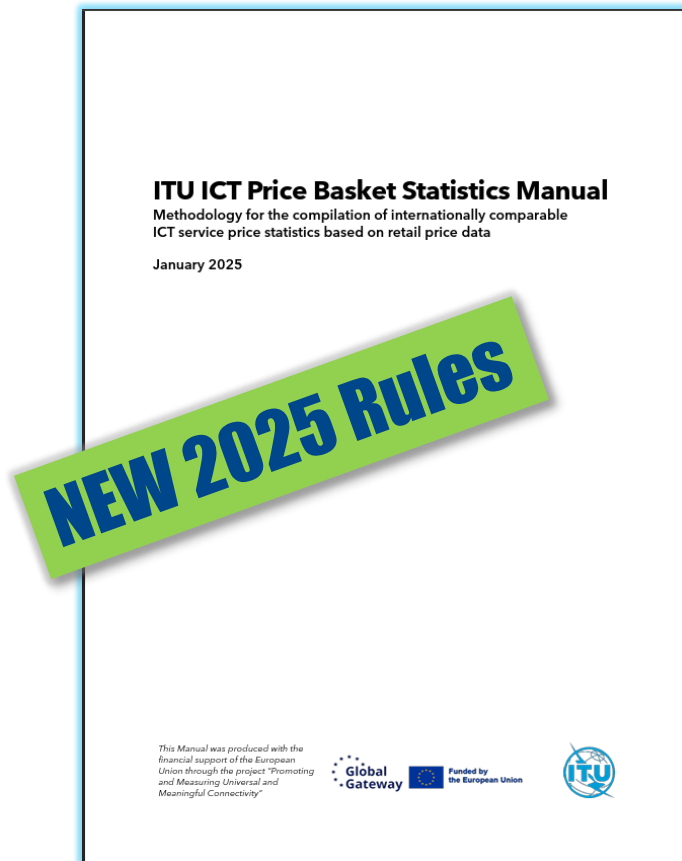

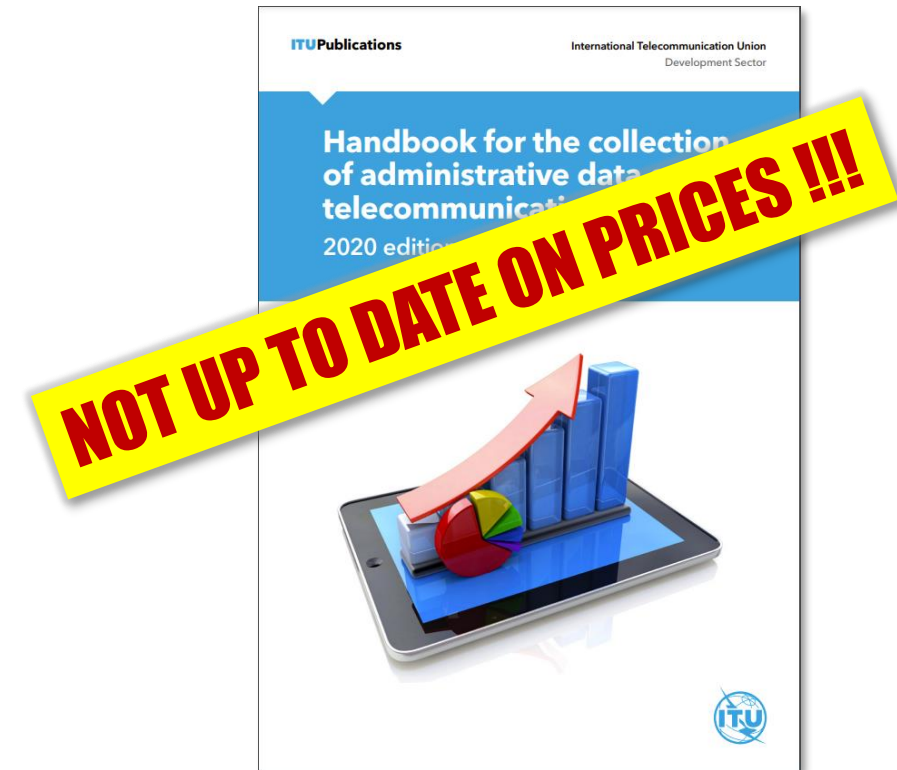

## **Contract modality: prepaid or postpaid?**

Select the **cheapest option**, **regardless of whether it is a prepaid or post-paid**, and regardless of whether it represents the majority use

 Change of practice since 2025 IPBQ (EGTI 2024 agreement)





## Commitment periods

**Fixed-broadband basket:** 12 months commitment period preferred



**Mobile [broadband] baskets:** Not considered (since EGTI, 2024)

**Fixed-broadband basket :** “In case operators propose different commitment periods, the 12-month plan (or the one closest to this commitment period should be used). If the plan selected requires a longer commitment (i.e. above 12 months), it should be indicated in the note of the monthly subscription. Furthermore, if there are different prices (for example, a discounted price for the first year, and a higher price as of the 13th month), then the price after the discount period should be selected (e.g. the price as of the 13th month). “



# What are promotional plans?

- Plans advertised for limited time period;
- Plans restricted for selected user groups
  - E.g., Existing subscribers only (to same or other products); new customers only
  - Plans restricted for students, under 26, retired, fleet members, etc.
  - Special prices for calling certain numbers or on certain days
  - Mobile broadband plans limited to certain types of devices
- Clearly indicated as promotional

→ Do not use promotional plans

## **exceptions / special considerations (assess on a case-by-case basis):**

- Offers with short shelf life due to high inflation
- Lower prices for online-only in a country with high Internet usage /i.e., not a restriction/
- “Constant promotions” – operators in some countries always call plans “offer” or indicate as promotions, but those are not for limited time only

## Can we use bundled services?

- Often difficult to isolate services provided together with multiple services
  - E.g., Fixed broadband Internet access + Fixed line telephony + TV
  - E.g., Voice + data services for mobile telephony
- **YES: If bundled service is the cheapest available option** to meet the minimum threshold, this bundle should be used
- Don't take plans partially
- Note: value for money is not a guiding principle

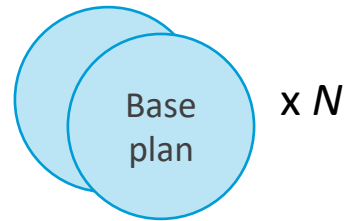
# Finding the cheapest options for mobile baskets

## Base-plan only



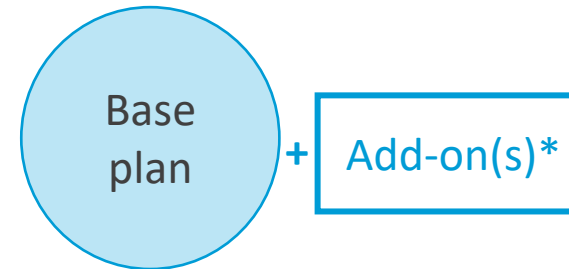
- The cheapest option is a single plan with the sufficient allowance & validity period to reach threshold
- Excess usage added if needed

## Multiple base plans



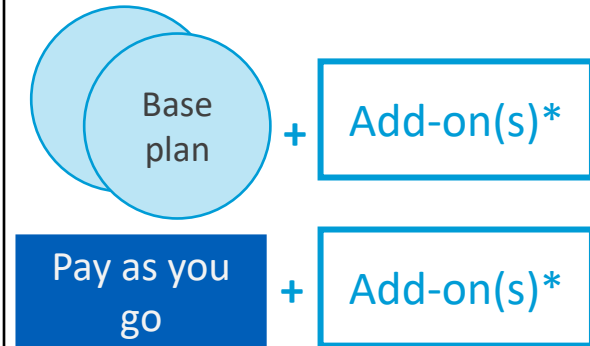
- A single plan to be taken multiple times to reach the necessary allowance & validity thresholds
- E.g., use 4 x weekly plan

## Base plan + Addon(s)



- The cheapest option is a base plan combined with an add-on to reach the necessary allowance & validity period
- Add-on(s) should be compatible with base plan;
- Add-on = Data/Voice/SMS (as needed)
- Add-on may also be a different plan, if compatible with the previous (e.g., 1 x 2-weekly + 2 x 1 weekly plan)

## "Patchwork"



- Any combination that meets the thresholds is acceptable, if compatible with one another;
- (e.g., multiple base-plans combined with add-ons)
- May include Pay-as-you go
- May include excess usage

### ⚠ 2 thresholds to meet

- ✓ **Allowance:** minimum [e.g. 5 GB]
- ✓ **Validity:** continuously for 30 days or 4 weeks



## The fixed-broadband basket (5GB)

- Which Internet Service Provider has the largest number of FBB subscriptions?
- What is the most commonly used technology?  
(**Fiber? DSL? Fixed Wireless** /any, e.g. 4G or 5G/?) → consider these plans only!
  - Technology: indicate all technologies offered for a plan (if location-specific)
  - What is a *fixed* wireless? → Contract should specify location!
- Are prices location-specific? → indicate a typical address in the questionnaire
- Residential or business plans?
- Restrictions on usage?
- “Unlimited” in practice? → Throttled? → if throttled speed <256kbps, limited!
- What are the recurrent monthly charges you need to pay to access the Internet?  
(Line & Internet separately? Add both, taxes included)
- One-off charges: separately

# Mobile broadband baskets



- Which mobile operator has the largest number of subscriptions?
- What are the tax rates? → Add all (VAT and other applicable taxes faced by consumers;)
  - Some cases, data and voice services have different taxes.
- Prices should be collected based on **3G technologies or above**:
  - (such as UMTS, HSDPA+/HSDPA, CDMA2000, IEEE 802.16e, LTE, LTE-Advanced and WiMAX/WirelessMAN) with an advertised download speed of at least 256 kbit/s.
  - The plans should apply irrespective of the device used (mobile phones, tablets, USB dongles). Prices applying to WiFi or hotspots should be excluded.
  - Allows both upload and download at broadband speeds
  - If a plan advertises unlimited data but reduces the speed below 256 kbit/s after a certain volume, only the portion consumed before throttling is considered broadband data.
- The cheapest plan should be chosen **without regard to the plan's modality (prepaid or postpaid)**. The modality of the reference plan should be recorded. When a postpaid plan is the cheapest plan, the minimum length of the contract should also be recorded in the notes.



# Mobile broadband baskets



- **Bundles** (that include other services) are also accepted [provided that this is the cheapest option]
- Take note of **fair usage policy** limits in case of plans advertised as “unlimited”
- Non-recurrent fees, such as installation/set-up fees are not collected.
- **Zero-rated services** (i.e., services that can be consumed besides the monthly data allowance, such as via certain platforms or applications – typically OTT, social media) should be **specified in a note** and should **not be counted** in the total data allowance volume.

## The data-only mobile broadband basket (5GB)

Refers to the cheapest available mobile data connection from the largest operator in a country, using 3G or more advanced technology, that allows at least 5 GB monthly Internet data usage and meets the data collection requirements specified below.

- The **minimum** monthly data allowance increased from 2 GB to 5 GB effective as of 2025
  - The selected plan should **not necessarily be the one with the cap closest to the basket's reference data volume** but include a minimum of the reference data volume.
  - 2 x Plan A with a monthly 3 GB;
  - 1 x Plan B with monthly 10 GB plan
  - 1 x Plan A with a monthly 3 GB + a 2 GB data add-on. Select the cheapest!
  - Data volumes should refer to both upload and download data volumes.
  - If prices are linked to 'hours of use' and not to data volumes, this information should be added in a separate note. [Note: ITU will most likely not be able to include these cases in a comparison.]
- **Pay-as-you-go** offers also acceptable if they are the cheapest option for a given basket or the only option available.



# The mobile data and voice baskets (high & low consumption)

- Broadband baskets – so the same rules apply as for data-only mobile broadband
- Baskets may include **stand-alone services**, **bundled services** or a **combination of the two** as long as the cheapest options are selected that meet the following thresholds:
  - Low-consumption data-and-voice basket: 70 minutes, 50 SMS and 1 GB.
  - High-consumption data-and-voice basket: 140 minutes, 20 SMS and 5 GB.
  - High-consumption data-and-voice basket (temp.): 140 minutes, 70 SMS and 2 GB.
- **Minimum thresholds:** The selected plan should not necessarily be the one with the data, voice and SMS allowances closest to the defined consumption set for each data-and-voice basket, but rather the **cheapest** including the minimum allowances set for each consumption profile.

Valid options - select the cheapest alternative [for the low-consumption]

  - 2 x Plan A: 35 minutes, 25 SMS and 500 MB monthly
  - 1 x Plan B: unlimited domestic voice and SMS and 2 GB data
  - 1 x Plan C: unlimited voice and 1 GB data + 50 SMS add-on

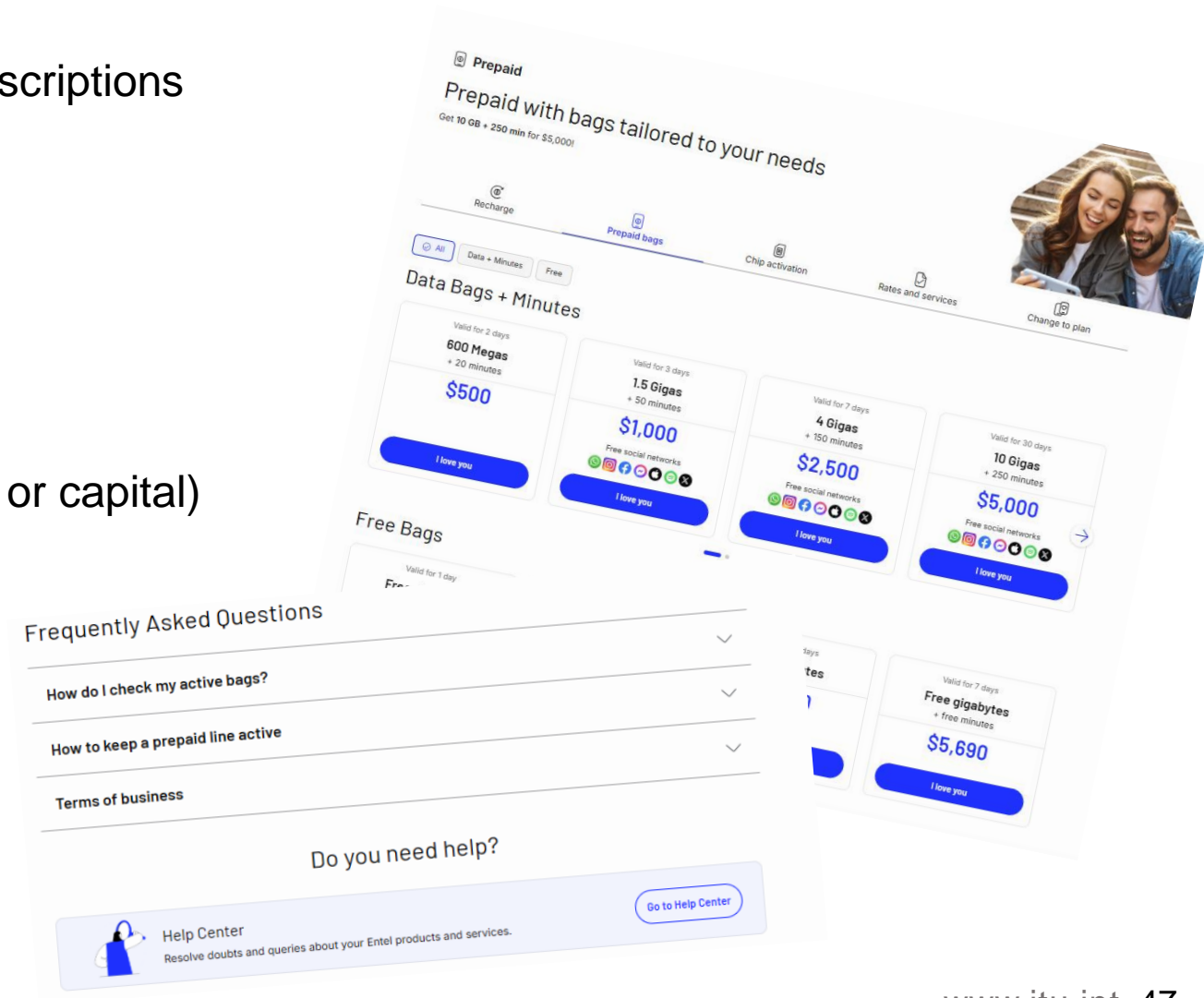

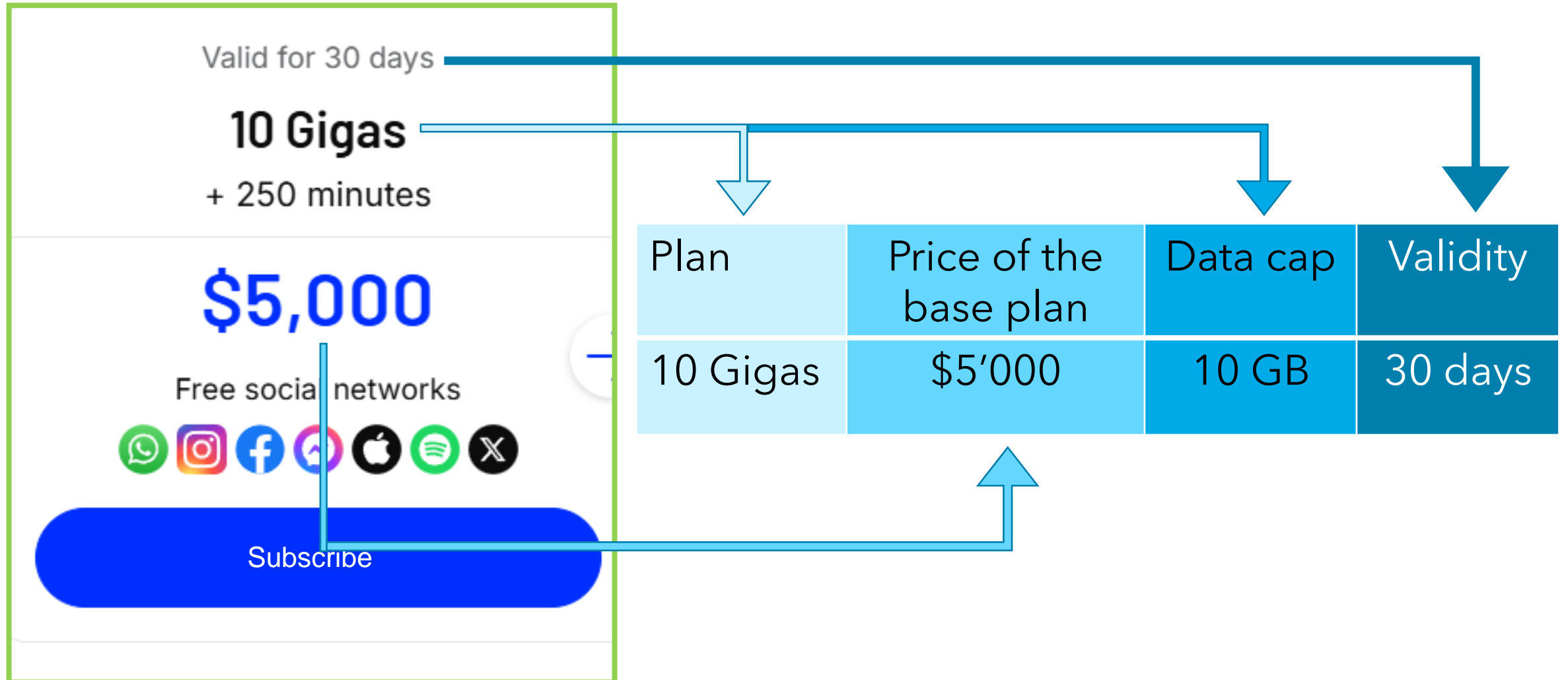

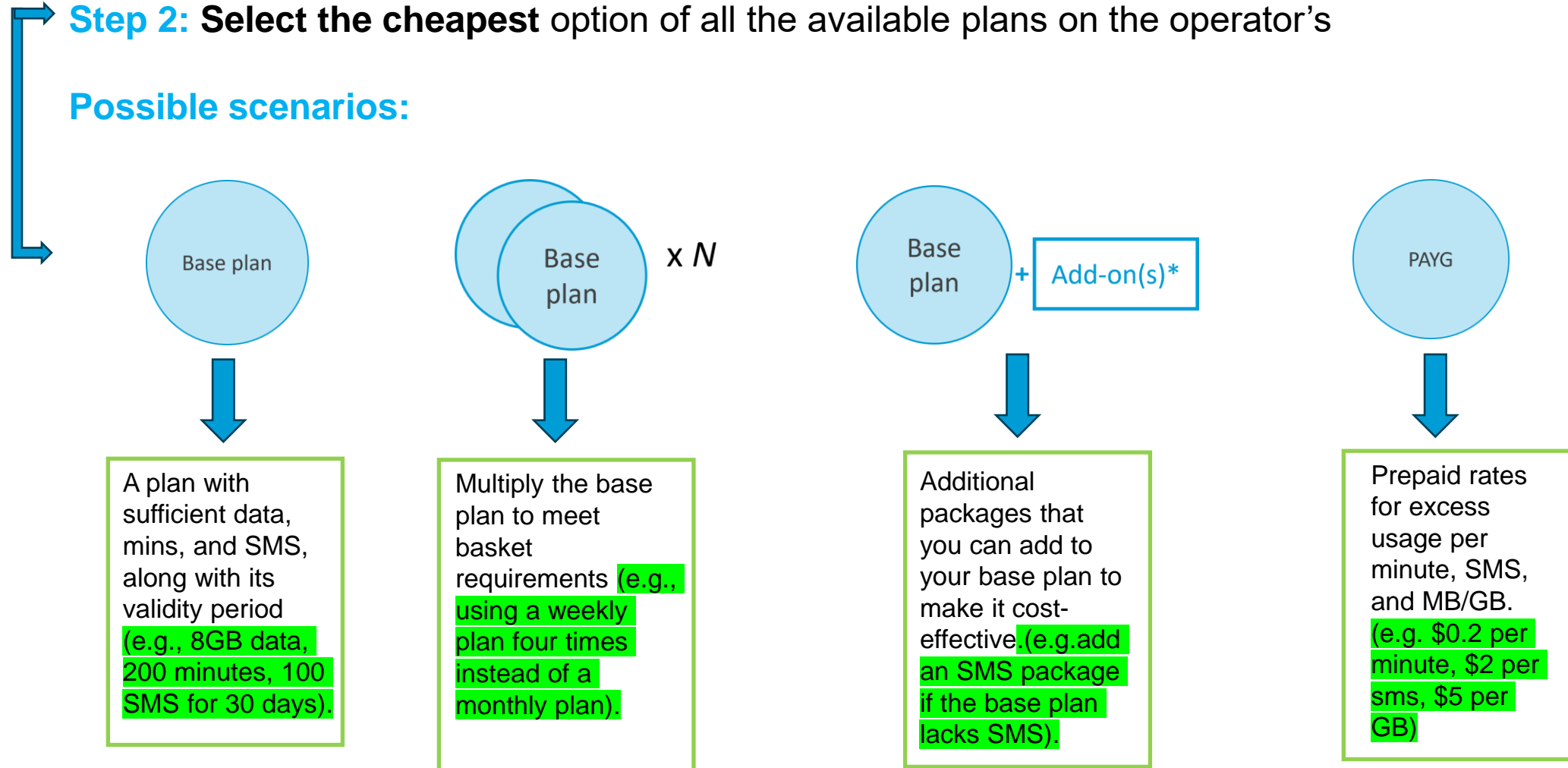

## Summary

- For each basket, follow these 4 steps:
  - Select the **majority operator** – if different from last year, please explain
  - Carefully **review all available options**: prepaid and postpaid plans, PAYG options, add-on packages, assess allowances and validity periods, consider taxes
    - Keep in mind: thresholds are minimum – can be overshoot;
  - Select the **cheapest** solution and retrieve screenshots
  - Enter all the information (**metadata**) in the questionnaire and explain the choice and calculation
- Look for retail prices – from a [cost-conscious] **consumer's perspective!**
  - What is advertised on the websites?



## Summary (cont'd)

- 2025 Revisions:
  - New allowance thresholds
  - Postpaid options are OK, breakout fees do not count
- ITU will review, compute basket totals in local currency and convert to USD, PPP\$ and calculate GNI p.c. rates;

# Key takeaways

- Basket  $\neq$  Plan!  $\leftarrow$  many solutions to meet basket requirements!
- Add-ons: real add-ons  $\leftrightarrow$  computed total based on PAYG rates

- When in doubt, reach out to the ITU team!
  - If cannot submit: ITU Desk research covers gap
- Prices are time sensitive: please respect the submission deadline!

- **Quality assurance:** evidence is essential!

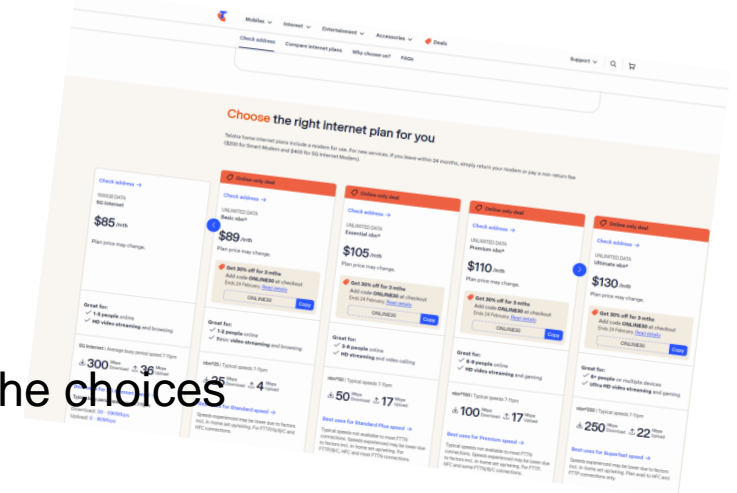
ITU conducts meticulous data verification (takes time!)

- How can you help?  
Follow carefully the data collection rules

**Provide supporting evidence:** screenshots, etc.; explain clearly the choices

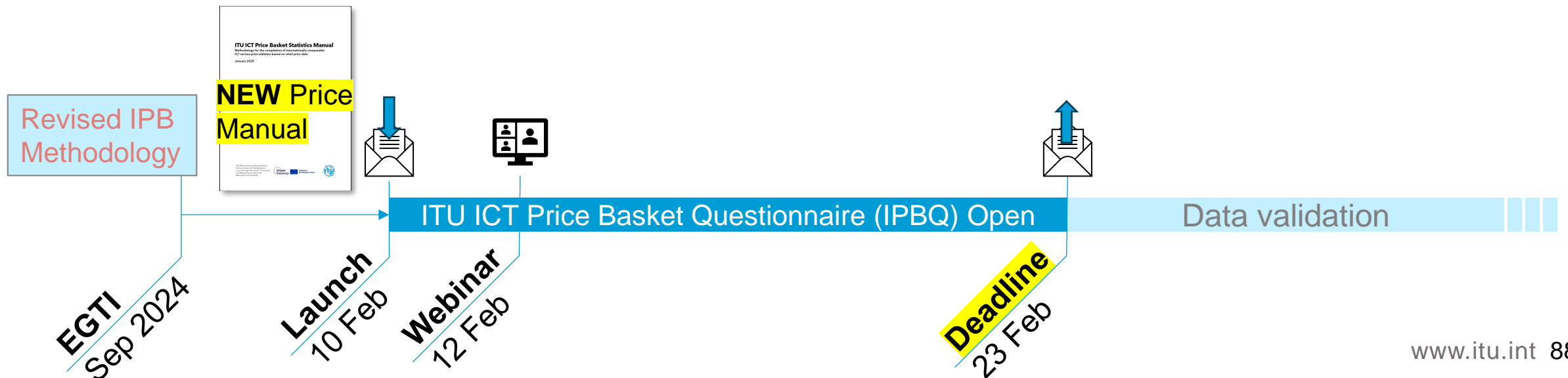
