## Subject:4th Meeting of the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators (EGH) and<br/>7th Meeting of the Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI)<br/>4-7 October 2016, Geneva, Switzerland

Dear Sir/Madam,

I am pleased to invite your organization to the 2016 meetings of the Expert Group on ICT Household Indicators (EGH) and the Expert Group on Telecommunication/ICT Indicators (EGTI) which will take place in Geneva from 4 to 7 October 2016.

The objective of these meetings is to examine the contributions received from members of the EGTI and EGH online discussion forums over the current working period, with a view to finalizing the items under discussion. The outcome of the discussions will be presented at the 14th World Telecommunication/ICT Indicators Symposium (WTIS), which will be held in Botswana, on 21-23 November 2016.

The statistical topics that will be covered during the EGH meeting include, among others: indicators on employment using ICT skills and tools; a new mobile phone metric; indicators on purchasing or ordering ICT goods or services; improving the data availability of ICT statistics (i.e. SDG indicators); national coordination among ICT data producers and users; and methodological issues related to data collection, verification and dissemination of ICT statistics.

The main statistical topics that will be discussed during the EGTI meeting are: the ITU price baskets; IoT indicators; the data collection on m-banking services; fixed network coverage indicators; and the guidelines for measuring international connectivity.

The meetings will also include a joint session of the two expert groups to discuss two standing agenda items: the use of big data in official statistics and the ICT Development Index (IDI).

The experience and expertise of your organization in the field of telecommunication/ICT statistics will greatly contribute to the success of these meetings. We therefore count on your presence and valuable inputs to the discussions.
