Mr Teppei Sakano graduated from Waseda University's Faculty of Science and Technology in 2001 and founded SkillsUpJapan Corp. during the same year. After SkillsUpJapan's video delivery platform business was acquired, the company's focus shifted to medical ICT.

In 2015, SkillsUpJapan was renamed Allm Inc, and in the same year, the company released "Join", a seamless medical communication application. "Join" became the first software/smartphone application covered by Japan's national health insurance. To date, Allm has expanded to 20 nations and collaborated with public, private, academic, and local NGO/NPO stakeholders to realize a world with healthcare access for all.
