B. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Visa formalities

The Republic of Uzbekistan has bilateral visa-free arrangements with the Republic of Azerbaijan, Republic of Armenia, Republic of Belarus, Georgia, Republic of Kazakhstan, Kyrgyz Republic, Republic of Moldova, Russia and Ukraine.

Participants requiring a **visa** to enter the Republic of Uzbekistan are advised to contact their local Embassy/Consulate of the Republic of Uzbekistan for information well in advance.

Entry visas are issued to foreign citizens at diplomatic and consular missions of the Republic of Uzbekistan abroad on the basis of the visa support letter (permission from the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan). At the Tashkent International Airport Consular Bureau, visas can only be issued to foreign citizens arriving from countries where there are no diplomatic or consular missions of the Republic of Uzbekistan. In such cases, visa support is required from the host administration.

For visa support, participants are kindly requested to complete the visa support form, which is available on the website of the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Uzbekistan: <http://evisa.mfa.uz/>, and e-mail it, along with a copy of their passport, to the event coordinator Mr Izzatilla Ikramov at: i.ikramov@mitc.uz; orirchs@mitc.uz by **1 June 2019**.

2. Vaccinations

No vaccination certificate is required for entering the country.

3. Language

The official language of the Republic of Uzbekistan is Uzbek.

4. Measuring system:

The official measuring system in Uzbekistan is the international metric system.

5. Driving

In Uzbekistan, vehicles circulate on the right-hand side.

6. Time

Time in Uzbekistan is 5 hours ahead of Greenwich Mean Time (GMT+5).

7. Electricity supplying

In Uzbekistan the power plugs and sockets are of type C. The standard voltage is 220 V, 50 Hz.



8. Climate

The climate of Uzbekistan is sharply continental, characterized by high amplitude of day and night. The temperature varies rather considerably with respect to the seasons. Average temperature in June is around +30 - +35°C.

9. Currency

National currency unit in the Republic of Uzbekistan is Uzbekistan sum (UZS). All payments are effected in the national currency. Currency exchange offices are available in all cities.

As of 7 May 2019, UZS exchange rate was as following:

1 USD = 8 448.89 UZS, 1 EUR = 9 462.76 UZS.

10. Business hours

Banks and exchange offices:

Banks open from Monday to Friday from 09:00 to 18:00 hours.

exchange is carried out by all banks and exchange offices. Exchange office at the hotel is open 24 hours, also 24 hours ATMs can be used.

Company offices:

Generally from 09:00 to 18:00 hours.

Shops and businesses:

In the major cities, Monday to Sunday from 09:00 to 23:00 hours.

Cafes, patisseries and pizzerias:

open from 09:00 to 23:00 hours

Restaurants:

Lunch is served from 11:00 hours and dinner from 18:00 hours. Many fast-food establishments are open round the clock.

11. Telecommunications

There are three fixed line telephony providers working in Uzbekistan: JS "Uzbektelecom", JV "Est Telecom", JV "Buzton". Mobile communication is provided by Uzdunrobita – trade mark "MTC" (GSM), Unitel – trade mark "Beeline" (GSM), Coscom – trade mark «U-cell» (GSM), UzMobile (CDMA 450).

Telephone code of Tashkent is +998 71. A local call from a regular phone will cost around 7 sum per minute. For international calls from Tashkent one should dial 00 + code of the country + code of the city or follow the instructions on telephone card.

The seminar participants can get Internet access in the respective hotels and at the event venue.

12. General information

The Republic of Uzbekistan is located between the rivers of Amudarya and Syrdarya and occupies 447 400 square kilometres. The span of the territory from the west to the east is 1 425 km and from the north to the south – 930 km. The Republic of Uzbekistan is bordered by five landlocked countries: the Republic of Kazakhstan to the north; the Republic of Tajikistan to the south-east; the Kyrgyz Republic to the north-east; Afghanistan to the south; and Turkmenistan to the south-west.

Tashkent is the capital of the Republic of Uzbekistan. It is located in the north-east of the Republic. Tashkent is the most important political, economic, cultural and scientific centre of the country, as well as a hub for rail, road and air transport. Tashkent is one of the oldest cities in central Asia. Its history goes back more than 2 000 years. It has a population of over 2.5 million. Tashkent has two railway stations serving long-distance and local destinations, two airports and several suburban bus stations. In 1977, the Tashkent Metro was brought into use; it now has three lines in operation and covers almost all districts of Tashkent.
