B. GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Visa Formalities

2. Vaccinations

Fiji is only open to fully vaccinated travelers and their accompanying minors. All travelers (16 years and above) must display proof of full COVID-19 vaccination at airport check-in prior to departure for Fiji.

For countries that do not offer vaccinations for those below 18 years, unvaccinated travelers who are 16-17 years old can apply for a special exemption at covidexemption@gmail.com

Note:

Fully vaccinated means that you have received the recommended number of initial doses (usually 2) of a vaccine that is recognised in Fiji. Vaccine booster shots are considered as additional protection to full vaccination.

Fiji currently recognises AstraZeneca, Pfizer, Moderna, Johnson and Johnson, Nuvaxovid (Novavax), Coronavac (Sinovac), Covishield, BBIBP-CorV (Sinopharm), Covaxin and Sputnik V. vaccines only.

3. Language

English is the official language in Fiji.

4. Measuring System

The official measuring system in Nadi – Fiji is the International Measurements System.

5. Driving in Fiji


In Fiji vehicles drive on the left side of the road.

6. Electricity supply

Electricity: 240volts. If this voltage is different from your home country, some hotels offer adapters to their guests or adaptors can be purchased from local hardware and electrical stores.

Alternating current (50 Hz) is used.

The type of electric plug-in used in Fiji is Type I plug as the following one:



7. Climate & Weather

The climate in Fiji is tropical warm and sunny climate year-round with minimal extremes. The average daytime temperature is about 28 degrees Celsius. The warm season is from November to April, and the cooler season lasts from May to October. Temperatures in the cool season average 22 °C (72 °F).

Rainfall is variable, with the warm season experiencing heavier rainfall, especially inland. For the larger islands, rainfall is heavier on the southeast portions of the islands than on the northwest portions. For example, Nadi on the western side of Viti Levu has reliably sunny weather in comparison to Suva on the southern side of the island. Winds are moderate, though cyclones occur about once annually.

8. Currency

The Fijian dollar (FJD) is the official currency of Fiji. While the FJ dollar is generally accepted, foreign currency can be exchanged at local banks and other authorised establishments. The generally accepted credit cards are American Express, VISA and MasterCard.

Exchange rates are liable to fluctuate. However, the average exchange rate can be:

US \$1.00 = FJ \$2.27

9. Shopping - Value Added Tax (VAT)

Value Added Tax, or VAT, is a 9% tax added to many goods and services in Fiji. The prices displayed in stores usually include this tax, unless otherwise stated. Companies registered to charge VAT, must prominently display their VAT Certificate of Registration.

10. Business hours

Banks and exchange offices: Monday to Thursday – 9am to 5pm. Friday from 9am to 4pm.

Company offices: Generally, from Monday to Friday 8am to 4.30pm. Shops and businesses: Monday to Saturday from 8am to 5pm.

Malls: Monday to Saturday 9am to 9pm

Cafes, patisseries, and pizzerias: Open till 10pm.

Restaurants: Lunch is served from 11am and dinner from 6 pm. Many fast-food establishments are open 24 hours.

11. Tipping

This is left to your own discretion; however, you can follow the guidelines below:

Taxi Drivers: 10% of the fare.

Service Staff at a Restaurant: 10% to 15 % of total bill.
