Event Venue:

Transportation From The Airport To The Meeting Venue:

Palmerola International Airport (XPL) is located in the Department of Comayagua and is the closest international airport to Tegucigalpa. The travel time between Palmerola Airport and Tegucigalpa by land transportation, is approximately one hour and thirty minutes (1:30). The transportation cost is approximately \$60. Please use official and safe transportation options, such as licensed taxis and popular transportation apps.

Currency and Payment Methods

The official currency in Honduras is the Lempira (L). Banknotes in circulation are 1, 2, 5, 10, 20, 50, 100, 200, and 500 Lempiras. The exchange rate for the Lempira fluctuates daily and is controlled by the Central Bank of Honduras. As a reference, for March 2025, the average exchange rate is 25.7 Lempiras per



US dollar. Please consult the current exchange rate on the official website of the Central Bank of Honduras. <https://www.bch.hn/>

Most ATMs accept VISA, MasterCard, and other cards for withdrawing Lempiras. Retail establishments commonly accept VISA and MasterCard debit and credit cards as well.

Language:

The official language in Honduras is Spanish.

Time Zone

Central Standard Time (CST) is maintained 6 hours behind Coordinated Universal Time (UTC-6) year-round.

Climate:

In Tegucigalpa, the month of June is generally rainy, with temperatures expected to range between 18°C - 26°C (64°F – 79°F); it's located in a terrain surrounded by mountains, at an average elevation of 990 meters (3250 feet) above sea level.

Electricity and Telephony

The voltage in Honduras is 110 Volts at 60 Hz. Standard 2-pin and grounded plugs are commonly available. Keep this in mind and bring an appropriate adapter if necessary.



The international dialing code for Honduras is +504. The mobile phone operators are CLARO and TIGO.

Emergency

In case of emergency, please contact the number nine one one (911), this system handles all types of emergencies in Honduras (*Police, Fire Department, Ambulance, and others*).

Personal Security Recommendations:

Always try to be accompanied when you wish to visit the city. Inform the event staff if you plan to go to a place in the city alone or in a group so they can provide safety recommendations.

At the airport and public places, do not leave bags or suitcases unattended. Be especially careful with your personal computer; always keep it in your hands. Shoulder bags or camera bags should always be kept in front of you. Avoid carrying large amounts of money, jewelry, or other valuable items such as cameras, cell phones, and others in the street.

Use ATMs located in busy public spaces and avoid using machines in streets or isolated areas. Do not accept anything from strangers on the street.

Whenever you go out, carry with you the hotel phone numbers and the mobile phone numbers of the event organizers.
