


Mission and Objective





THE ITU-R RESOLUTION ON GENDER

- The Radiocommunication Assembly 2023 in Dubai adopted **Resolution ITU-R 72** "Promoting gender equality and equity, and bridging the contribution and participation gap between women and men in ITU-R activities"
- This Resolution applies to the ITU Radiocommunication Sector, and its adoption has resulted from the joint effort and cooperation of all the Regions.

Participation in RA/WRC in 2019 and 2023




Gender Evolution_ Study Group




Present Participants by Gender



 3. Strengthen the ITU women's community by enhancing their numbers and active participation in the conference.
 4. Inspire the next generation of women in radiocommunications.




Why should I participate in NOW4WRC27 Mentoring Programme?

- Network with seasoned professionals and peers to expand opportunities.




Who can be a mentee or mentor?

All women ITU-R delegates are welcome to become mentees. Experienced women and men ITU-R delegates are encouraged to apply to the programme as mentors.

How does the matching work?

Once a completed registration form is returned by an ITU-R delegate, a mentee (woman delegate) will be paired with a mentor (experienced ITU-R delegate) using the criteria that best matches their interest in the topics on the agenda of the WRC-27, as well as their language/regional preferences.


