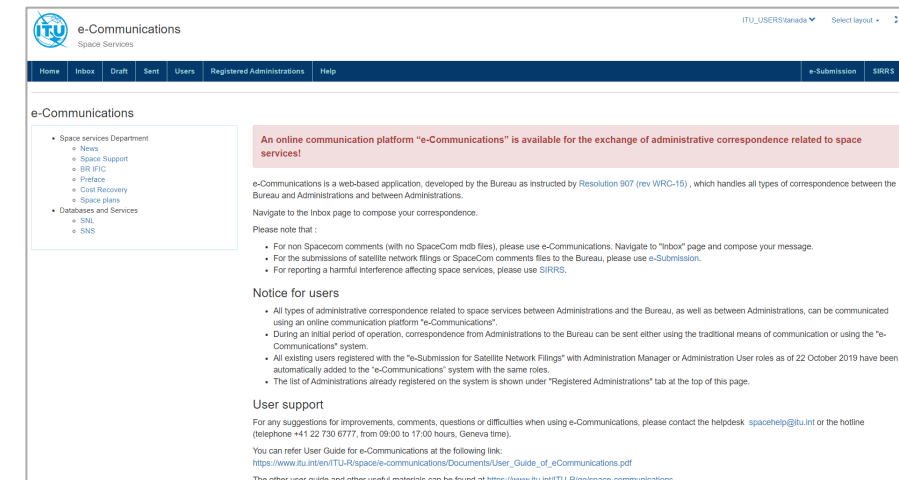
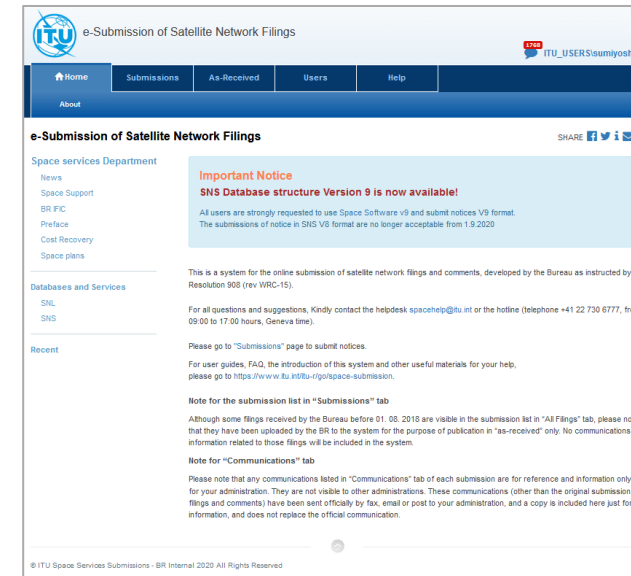

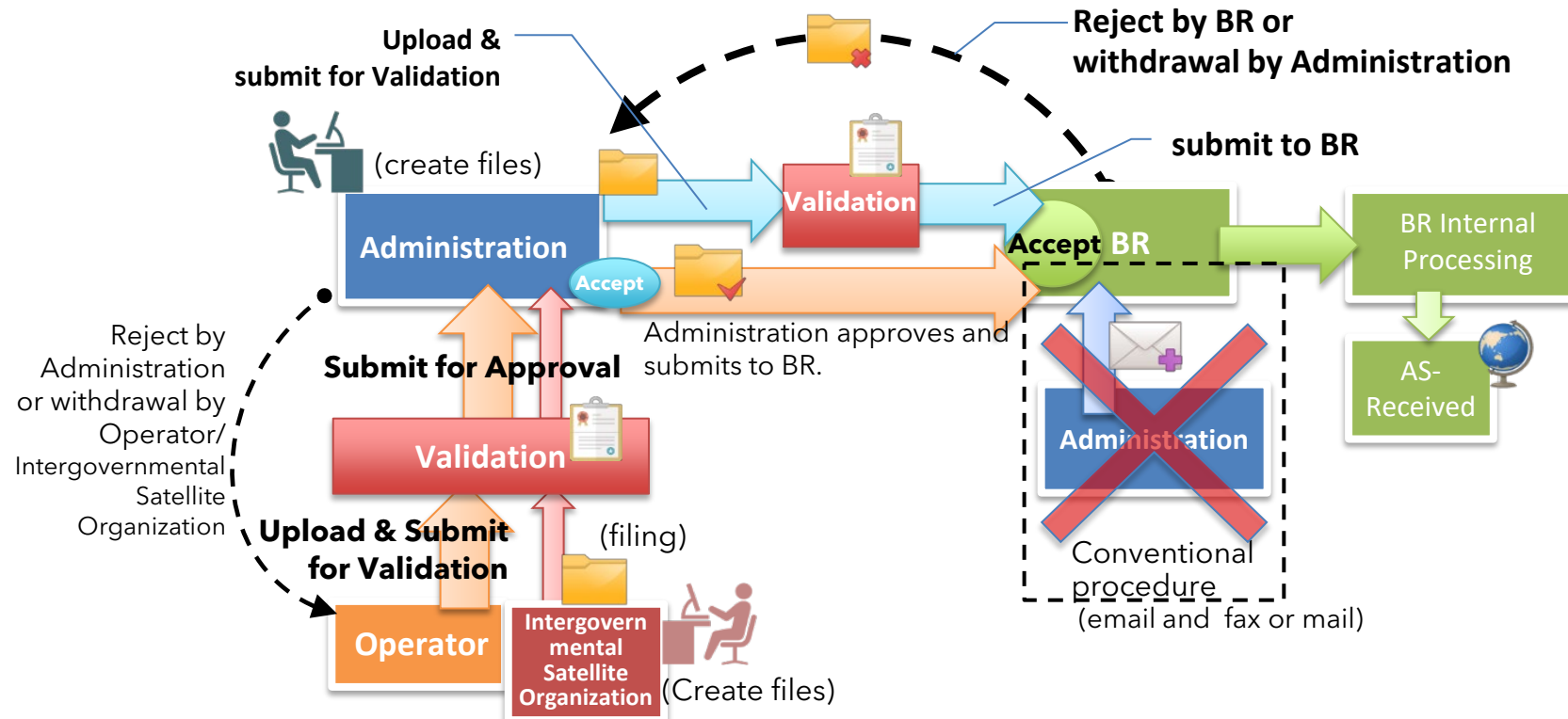

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# General Introduction (1)

- A web-based secure paperless online system to submit all satellite network filings and SpaceCom comment files.
- **Mandatory** online submissions via e-Submission from 1 August 2018
- Development in response to Resolution **908** (Rev.WRC-15)

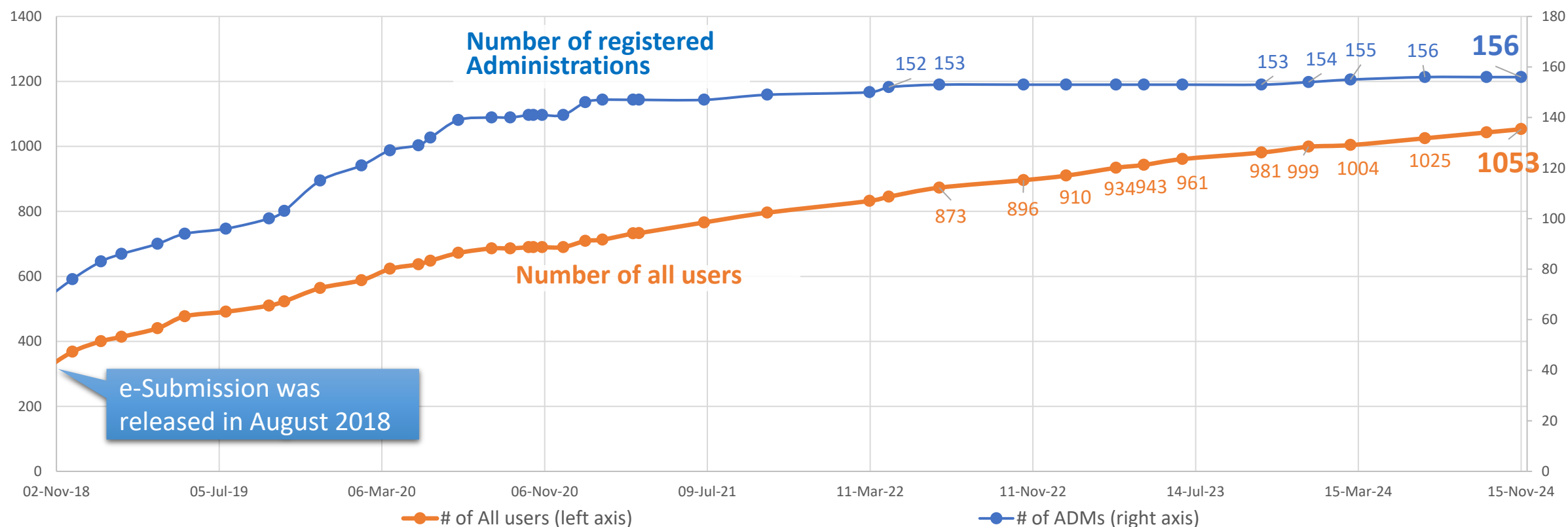

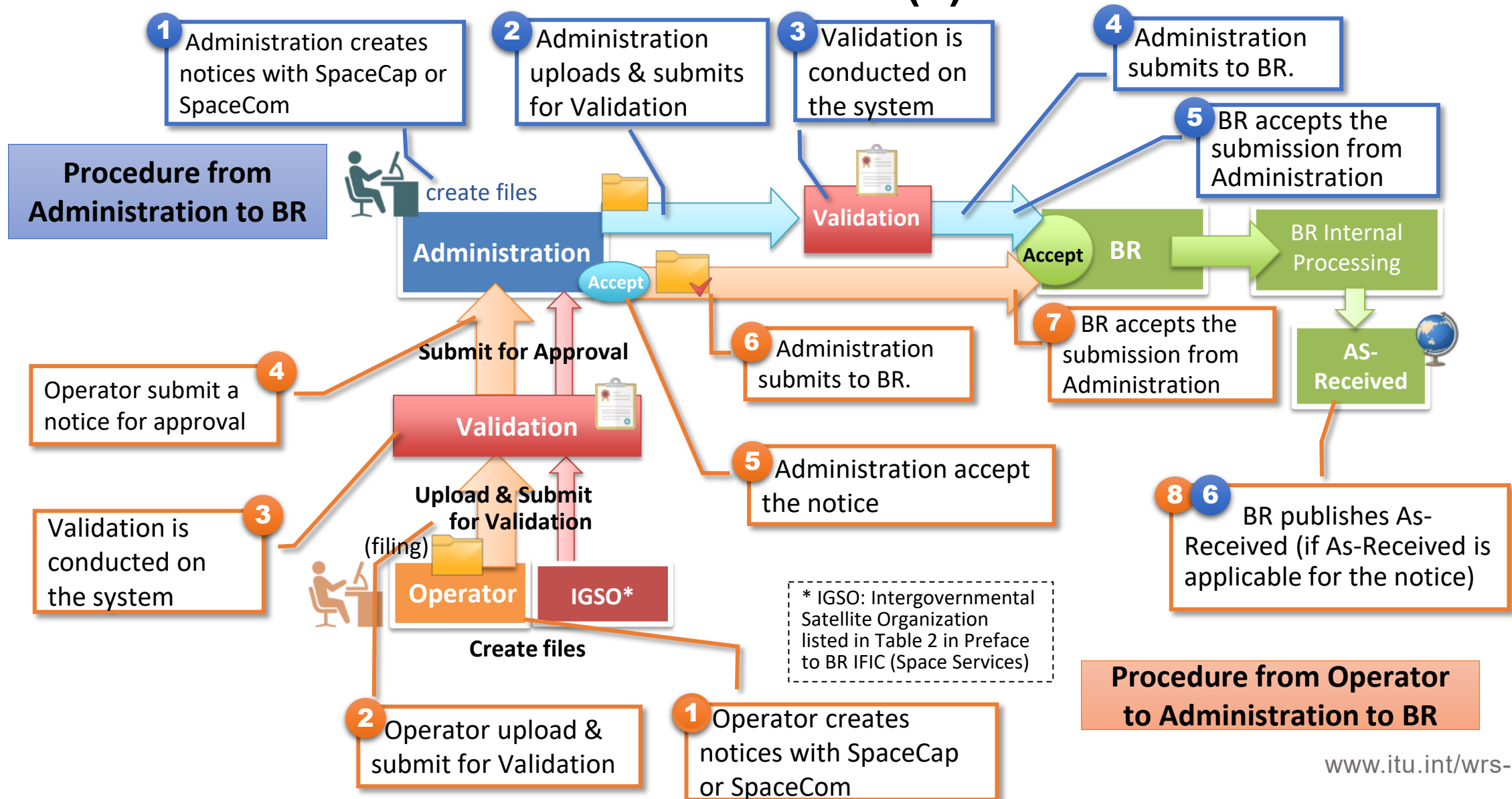
## e-Submission: Numbers of registered users and administrations

(# of ADMs)



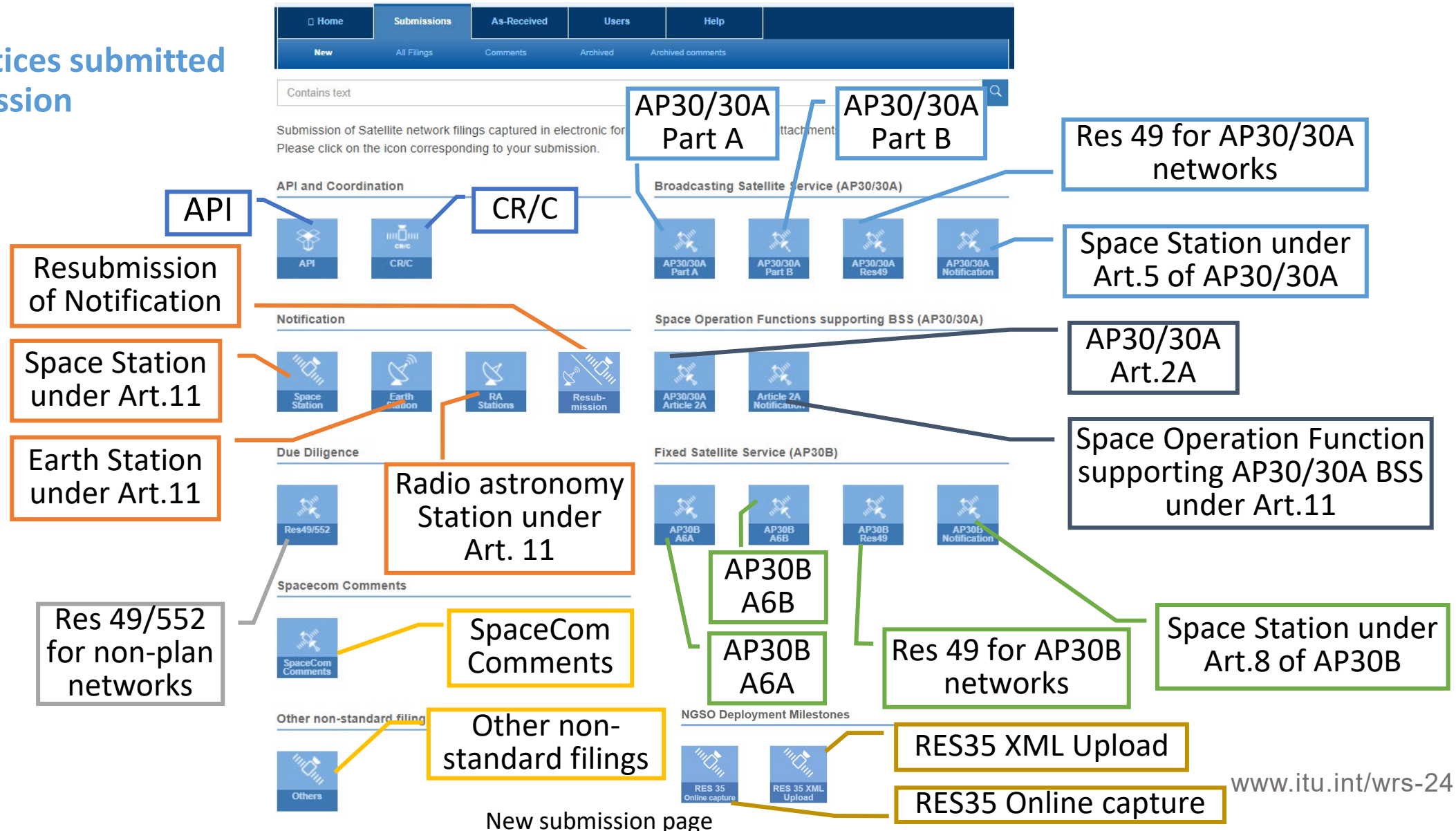

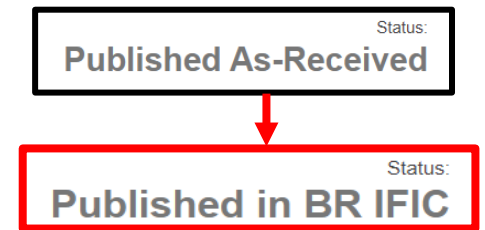

## Recent updates (1)

### New status “Published in BR IFIC”

- Automatic change of the status from “Published As-Received” to **“Published in BR IFIC”** for the notices published in a special section or Part I-S in a BR IFIC (Space Services)



### The new online examination tool “e-Examination”

- Assist users in verifying their compliance to PFD and EIRP limits specified in the Radio Regulations
- Automatic execution when a SNS file is uploaded
- Easy download of the e-Examination results

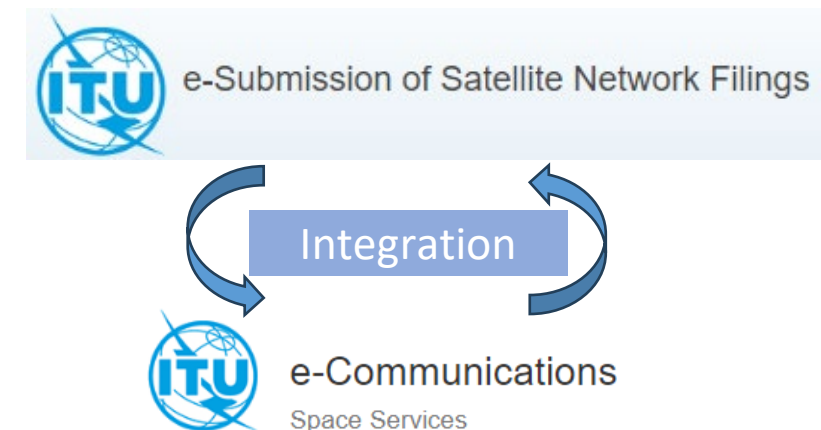

## Updates for SNS V10

- **From 1<sup>st</sup> January 2025, only SNS V10 are acceptable on e-Submission.**  
The submissions of notice in SNS V9.1 format will no longer be unacceptable on and after 1st January 2025.
- New types of notice will be accepted from 1 January 2025 according to the Radio Regulations revised at WRC-23.

# Common mistake for submissions by e-Submission

## ! Don't mistake Due Diligence information of Planned band for Non-Planned band

- BR often receives Res 49 of **Planned band** (AP30/30A and AP30B) through Res49/552 category of **Non-Planned Band**.
- A submission with wrong category may delay the treatment process.



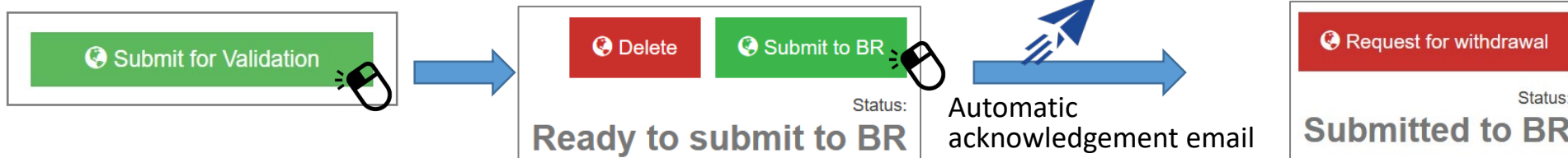

## ! Don't forget to click on "Submit to BR" after a validation process has finished

- Administration users sometimes leave a notice at the status of "Ready to submit to BR" relievedly after an online validation process completed successfully, where the notice hasn't been submitted to BR.
- Don't forget to click on "Submit to BR" and make the status "Submitted to BR" after an online validation processes have finished.**
- Users can confirm a submission to BR with receiving automatic acknowledgement email.

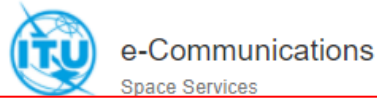

## Important note for e-Communications


1. Administrations registered on the system are **strongly requested to access e-Communications to check/read the incoming correspondence regularly.**
2. The Bureau encourages Administrations to indicate their willingness to use “e-Communications” as the only means of communication and to discontinue the traditional means of communication from Administrations.
3. Administrative correspondence between administrations and BR shall be communicated, whenever possible, using the e-Communications platform according to Resolves in Res **55 (Rev.WRC-23).**  
**Therefore, the use of e-Communications will be strongly encouraged.**

# Operation of the Systems

## -Submission via e-Submission, e-Communications and SIRRS-

- “e-Submission” for submissions of satellite network filings and SpaceCom comment files.
- “e-Communications” for sending and receiving administrative correspondence related to space services.
  - A reply to the correspondence from the Bureau on a clarification for the submitted notices is recommended to be sent via e-Communications (for both with and without a mdb file).
- “Satellite Interference Reporting and Resolution System” (SIRRS) for reports of harmful interference.

## Takeaways

1. “e-Submission” and “e-Communications” support Member States to submit space network filings and communicate with the Bureau or other administrations, and ultimately facilitate entire satellite coordination process.
2. Member States and Intergovernmental Satellite Organizations that have not yet nominated any Administration Manager or IGSO Manager for e-Submission and e-Communications are strongly urged to do so as soon as possible.
3. Communications via e-Communications are increasing. The use of e-Communications is strongly encouraged.
4. The systems are constantly being updated in accordance with requirements from Administrations and updates of regulations. The Bureau welcomes any suggestions and comments to improve the systems (email to [spacehelp@itu.int](mailto:spacehelp@itu.int)).

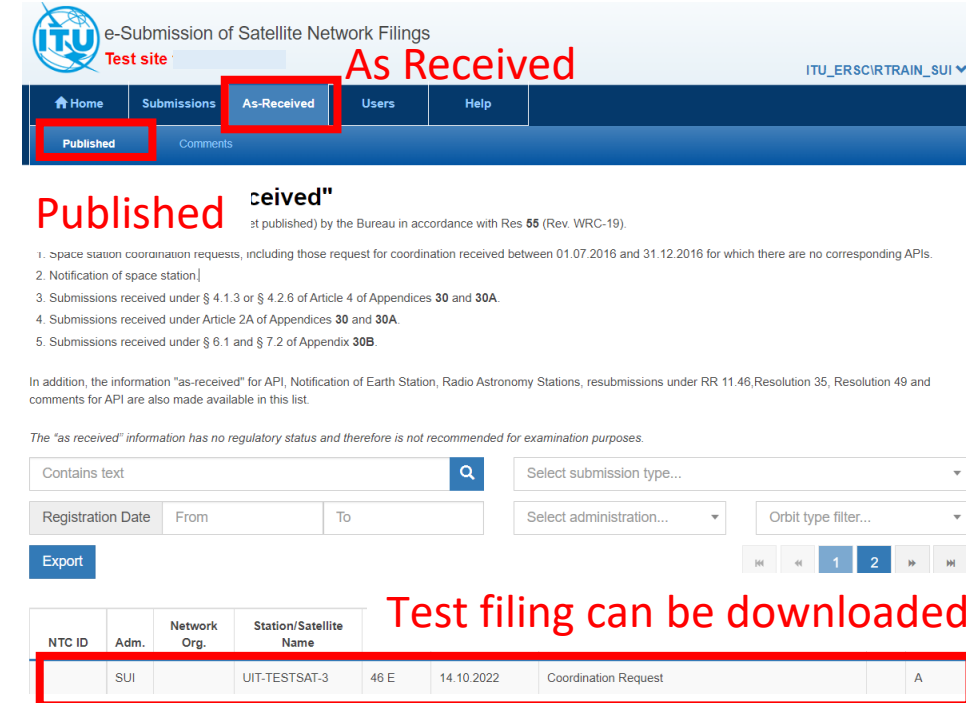

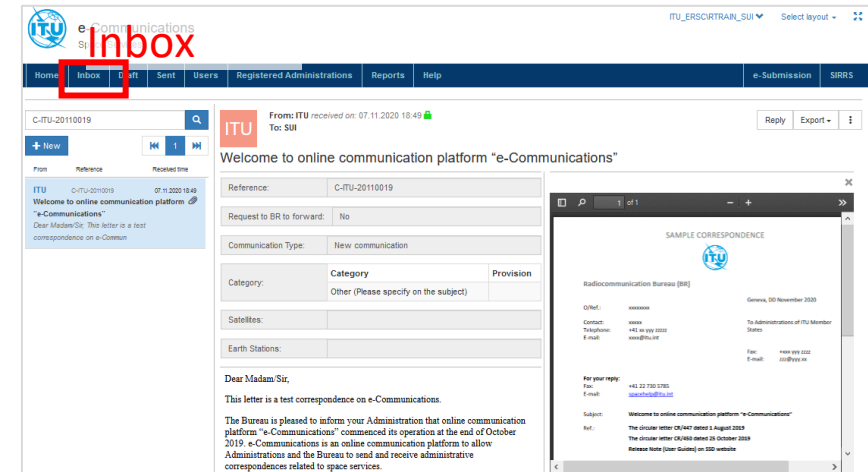

## Tips for the exercise on the test site

## Tips for submissions by e-Submission (1)

### ! Submit diagrams in GIMS file for submissions of API and Notification

 All graphical data shall be submitted in graphics data format compatible with BR's data capture software GIMS in accordance with Resolution **55** (Rev.WRC-23).

### ! Withdraw former SpaceCom file in submitting another SpaceCom file to the same IFIC

 Please withdraw initial SpaceCom comments file when submitting another SpaceCom comments file to the same IFIC in order to proceed the process in BR smoothly without confusions.

## Tips for submissions by e-Submission (2)

### ! Update email addresses for TIES accounts




-  Automatic acknowledgement emails are sent to your email address associated with your TIES account.
-  In order to deliver acknowledgement emails to you correctly, please keep to update your email address associated to your TIES account thorough TIES Services: <https://www.itu.int/en/ties-services/Pages/default.aspx>
-  Change email addresses associated with TIES accounts to ones which you use on your business if your email addresses associated with TIES account are free email addresses to which you don't access.

### ! Don't forget to attach supplemental information when you submit with SNS file



-  Please submit notes, clarifications or supplemental information which are not included in a SNS file or a GIMS file as separated files if necessary.
-  If such additional information is missing, the process might be delayed.

# Tips for communications on e-Communications

## ! Access e-Communications and read correspondence from other Administrations

-  Please access e-Communications frequently and read correspondence sent from other Administrations or BR at least when you receive automatic acknowledgment emails from e-Communications system.
-  If you don't receive any acknowledgment emails though you are a user of e-Communications, please **update your email address associated with TIES account to the email address you access frequently** in order to acknowledge correspondence your Administration receives smoothly.
-  The coordination process of your satellite network may be delayed if your Administration doesn't notice correspondence received via e-Communications.

## ! Rest assured that all correspondence sent to BR via e-Communications have been treated by BR

-  The Bureau is sometimes asked if the Bureau reads correspondence sent via e-Communications from Administrations because the history of correspondence doesn't change to "Read".
-  **The Bureau accepts and reads all of correspondence from all Administrations via e-Communications smoothly and processes them normally** even if the history on e-Communications does not show that the message has been read by ITU.
