

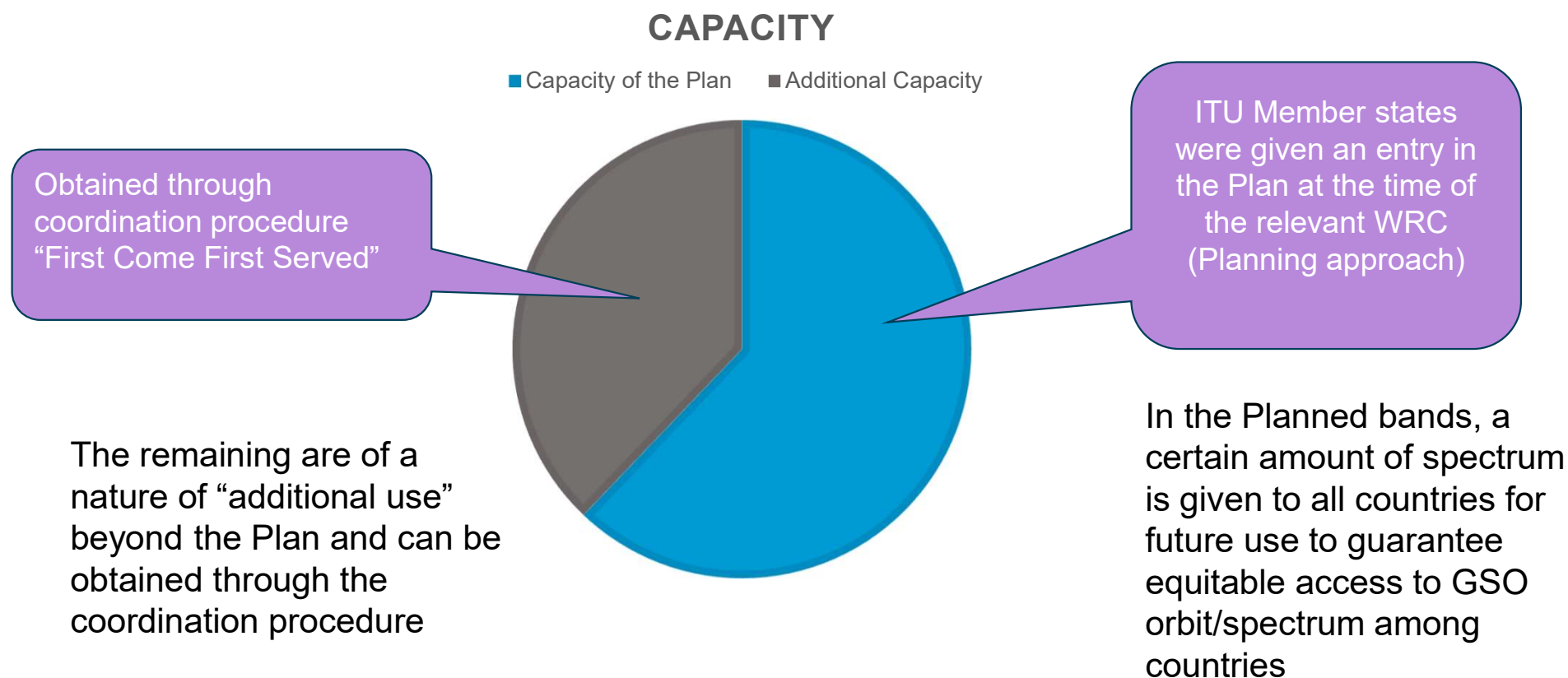

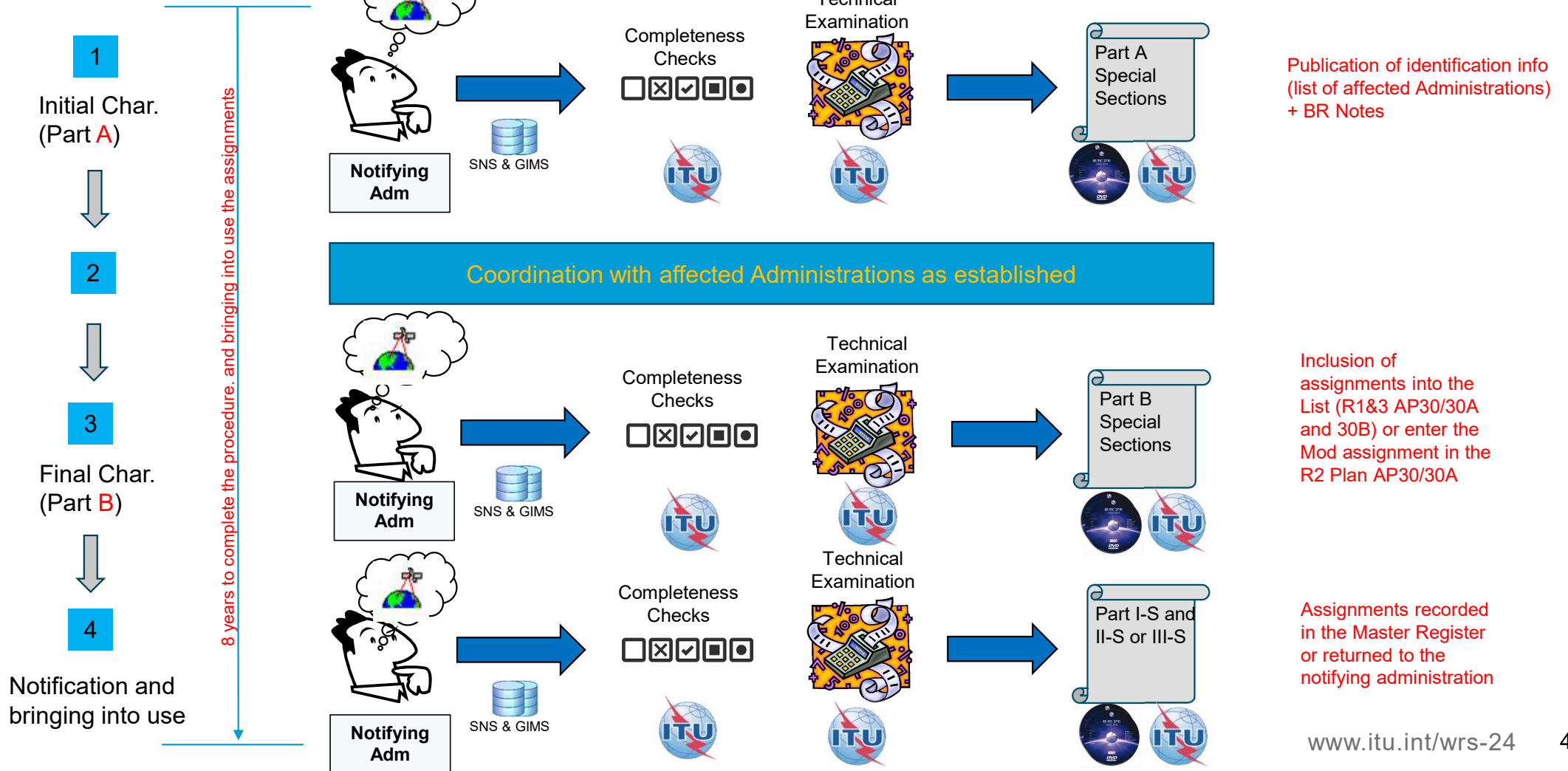

Overview of these procedures



Part A Submissions and completeness checks

On the Part of the Notifying Administration:

- The notifying Administration shall submit to the BR data in accordance with RR Appendix 4
- Prepare SNS database and GIMS database in MS Access mdb files
- Check compliance with any applicable hard-limits
- Take into account BR's comment on previous submissions
- Take into account future deployment of special applications (e.g. 30B ESIM)
- BR Validation software to validate before submission
- e-Submission System

Part A Submissions and completeness checks

On the Part of the BR:

- Publish “As received” in e-Submission
- Conduct completeness checks and communicate with Notifying Administration (30D for reply) in terms of:
 - Data consistency with AP4, coherence between these data, and that between the SNS and GIMS files
 - Propose changes to facilitate follow-up examinations
 - Propose other changes in case of possible omissions
 - A few particularities for AP30/30A and AP30B (see next page)
- Once the completeness stage is completed, we will have:
 - The formal date of receipt
 - Stable databases for technical examination (SNS+GIMS)

Part A Submissions and completeness checks

A few differences between AP30/30A and AP30B in BR's checks on completeness of Part A :

**In the interference calculation to entries (allotments or assignments) that are part of the group, only the interference contribution from entries that are not part of the same group are to be considered. On the other hand, for the interference calculation from entries belonging to a group into entries that are not part of the same group, only the worst interference contribution from that group is to be taken into consideration.*

Part A Technical Exam and Publication

The Bureau examines the notice in respect of two main aspects:

- Hard limits, if exceeded, the **exceeding assignments** will receive unfavourable finding (**not the whole notice !**)
- Identifications of potentially affected Administration's assignments and allotments

After that, the Part A Special Section is published:

- Characteristics of the Part A notice
- Identification information
- "BR Notes" to explain the purpose, method or any other point that BR deems important

1. Note relating to the identification of a notifying administration's own assignments

Explanation as to how to understand if in the identification table, the allotment and/or assignments of the Notifying Admin is/are listed.

Where a notifying administration is acting on its own behalf, and not on behalf of a group of named administrations, it should be understood that whenever its own assignments are identified as being potentially affected in AP30/E/, AP30A/E/ and AP30-30A/E/ Special Sections under § 4.1.1 a), 4.1.1 b), 4.1.1 e), 4.2.3 c) or 4.2.3 e) of Appendix 30 and 4.1.1 a), 4.1.1 b) or 4.2.2 c) of Appendix 30A, this identification is provided only for information. Responsibility for co-ordination between such assignments and the proposed assignments is an internal matter for the notifying administration.

2. Note relating to application of the grouping concept to a network with assignments internally grouped and not externally grouped with networks in a Plan/List

Application of the grouping concept in Regions 1 and 3 to a network with assignments only internally grouped is explained in Articles 11 and 9A of Appendices 30 and 30A respectively. Based on this concept, when calculating interference to assignments that are part of a group, only the interference contributions from assignments that are not part of the same group are included. Moreover, when calculating interference from assignments belonging to a group into assignments that are not part of the same group, only the worst interference contribution from that group is used.

3. Note relating to the application of § 4.1.1 e), 4.2.3 e) and 4.2.3 f) of Appendix 30

Explanation as to how the exam is conducted

The attention of administrations is drawn to the fact that, in its compatibility analysis, the Bureau has considered the applicable limits prescribed in sections 3 and 6 of Annex 1 to Appendix 30 and the corresponding service area of the subject FSS or non-planned band BSS assignments as submitted by the responsible administrations. This implies that if a submitted service area covers both land and sea, the corresponding FSS or non-planned band BSS assignments are protected anywhere on land and at sea within their respective service area communicated to the Bureau by the responsible administrations. This fact may be taken into account in the evaluation of eventual interference during the coordination process between the concerned administrations.

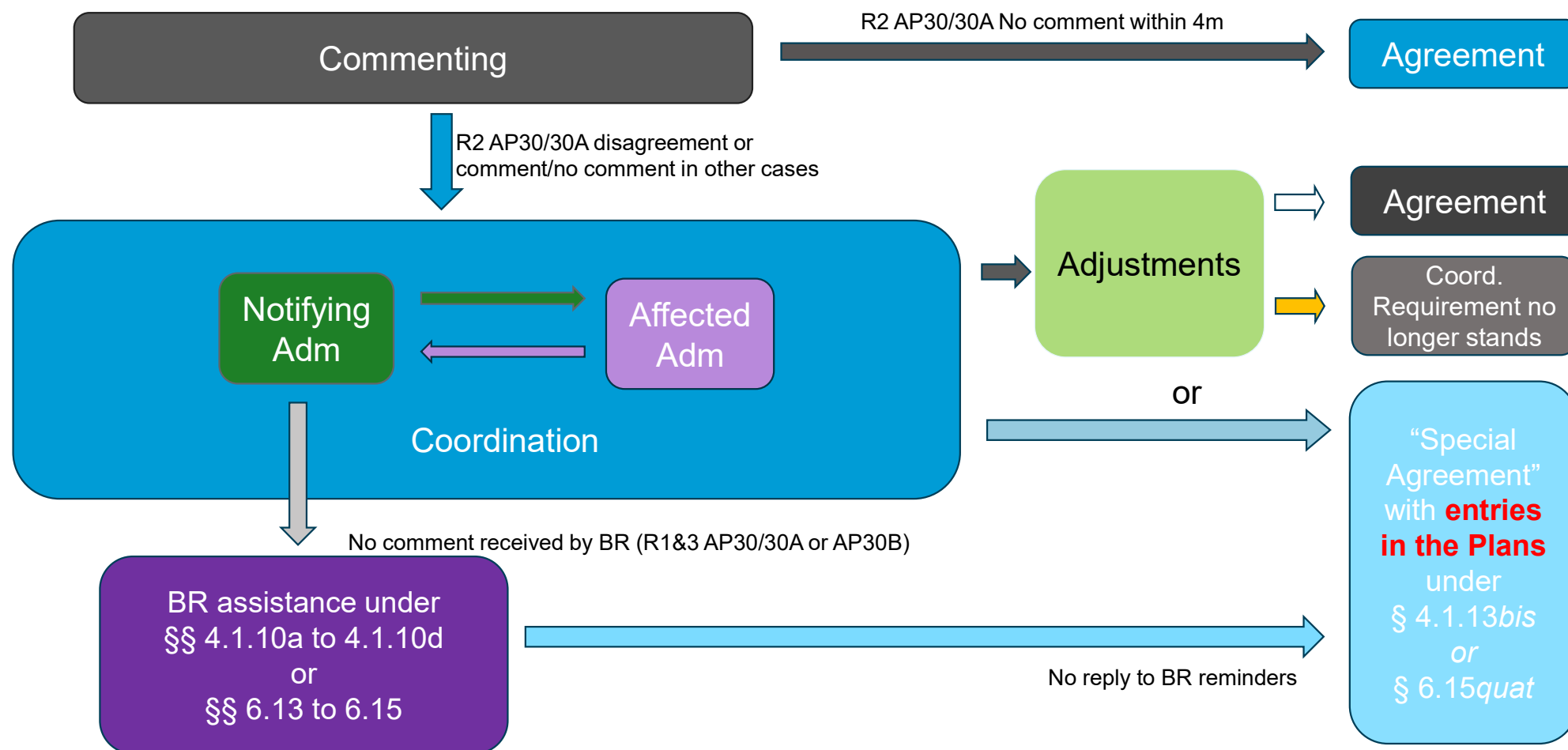
1. Note relating to the identification of a notifying administration's own assignments

Where a notifying administration is acting on its own behalf, and not on behalf of a group of named administrations, it should be understood that whenever its own allotments and/or assignments are identified as being potentially affected in AP30B/A6A/ Special Sections under § 6.5 of Appendix 30B, this identification is provided only for information. Responsibility for co-ordination between such assignments and the proposed assignments is an internal matter for the notifying administration.

2. Note relating to application of the grouping concept to a network grouped with (a) network(s) not in the List

Application of the grouping concept in Appendix 30B is explained in Rules of Procedure relating to § 6.5 of Article 6 of Appendix 30B. Under this concept, when calculating interference to assignments that are part of a group, only the interference contributions from allotments/assignments that are not part of the same group are included. Moreover, when calculating interference from assignments belonging to a group into allotments/assignments that are not part of the same group, only the worst interference contribution from that group is used.

Coordination and Agreement Seeking



Special Agreement

- Notifying administration provides a firm, objective, measurable and enforceable commitment to respect the PFD limit(s) as laid out in relevant provisions;
- When this special agreement is concluded, assignment/allotment of Affected Administration continue to be protected.
- Notifying administration shall begin to observe the limit no later than:
 1. The date of bringing into use of the AP30/30A R1&3 Plan assignment / AP30B national allotment and
 2. The date of receipt of the telefax under §§ 5.1.6*bis*/5.1.10*bis* or §8.10*bis* + 12 months,

whichever comes late.

Part B Submissions and completeness checks

On the part of the Notifying Administration:

- Submission shall be done within the 8-year regulatory limit
- Submission to the BR (SNS+GIMS), data in accordance with RR Appendix 4.
- Before that, run self-exam, especially on hard limits and vis-à-vis entries for which such provisions as § 6.25 or § 4.1.18 or § 4.2.21A cannot be applied.
- For hard limits of AP30B, if exceeded, the **whole notice** will be returned.
Possible loss of network !

Submission of a **single notice** for Part B and Notif.

Administrations can submit Part B and Notification as **two** separate submissions.

In addition, a single notice to represent both Part B and Notification is also accepted, but:

- AP30/30A: submission of Part B data (Art. 4) only, Notification (Art. 5) notice will be generated by BR
- AP30B: Notification data (Art. 8), Part B (Art. 6) notice will be generated by BR
- Cost recovery: Part B + Notification
- Mindful of the correct category in the e-Submission System

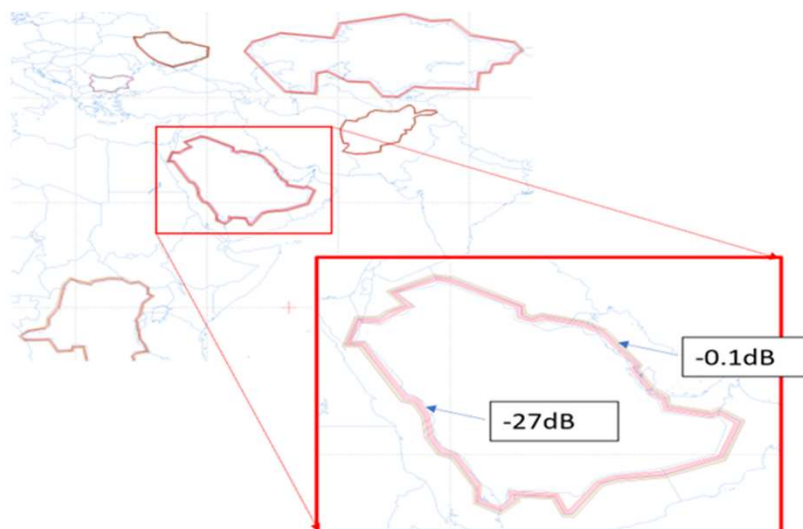

 - Data consistency with AP4, (pay attention to BR reminding text if it proposes changes that could increase interference)
 - Propose changes to facilitate follow-up examinations
 - Propose other changes in case of possible omissions
- Once the completeness stage is completed, we will have:
 - The formal date of receipt
 - Stable databases for technical examination

Part B Submissions and completeness checks

A few differences between AP30/30A and AP30B in BR's checks on completeness of Part B :

| Items | AP30/30A | AP30B |
|--------------------------------|---|--|
| Hard limits | BR will remind Notifying Administration if it finds excess of hard limits | Hard limits are examined under § 6.19 b), a step after completeness checks under § 6.18, therefore similar to Part A, BR does not check hard limits in completeness. Recommendation: Run BR-SIS Validation, GIBC/PFD/EIRP GSO and GIBC/AP30B/Annex 3 PFD before submission. This is even more important given the return of a whole notice in case a hard limit is exceeded! |
| Service area and coverage area | Regional. BR will request the alignment of gain contours with service area which are Regional. BR may propose to modify the service area in some situations, e.g. due to the location of the test points. | At Part B stage, the service area can only be a set of territories of administrations from which explicit agreements have been obtained. BR may propose to remove the portion of the service area where the C/N is very low. |
| Test points | Test points should be evenly distributed to represent the service area. If the number is found to be few, BR may propose adding them to the downlink service area. | Test points should be evenly distributed to represent the service area. If the number is found to be few, BR may propose adding them, even to the uplink area. But with a warning that the interference should be re-evaluated. |

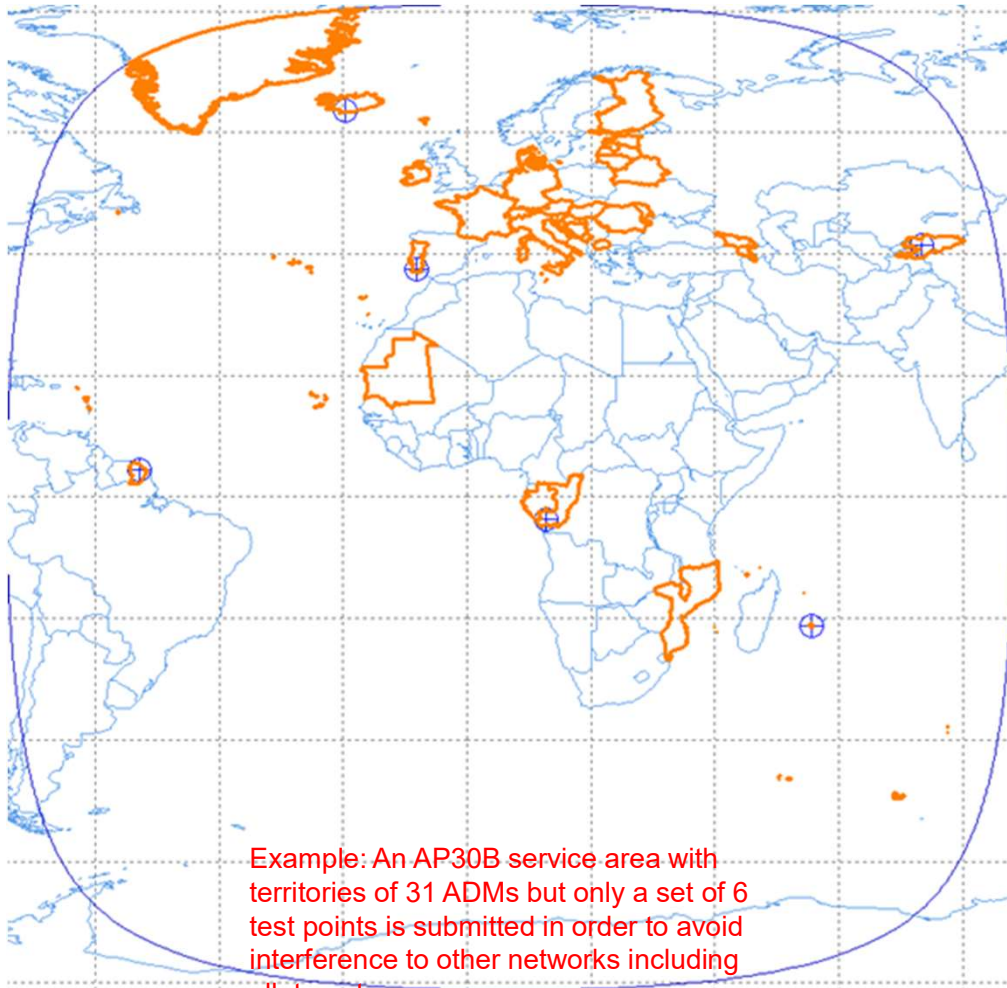

Few test points in uplink service area and special agreements



Example: An AP30B service area with territories of 31 ADMs but only a set of 6 test points is submitted in order to avoid interference to other networks including allotments.

The notifying ADM can place additional test points that could affect the Plan entries in respect of which the special agreements have been reached, thereby increasing the number of test points and improving the representation of the service area by the set of test points.

“Provisional entry” into the List/Plan

- For R1/3 AP30/30A and AP30B and for still affected assignments without agreement, it is possible to “insist” and request for “provisional entry” into the List. For R2 AP30/30A, it is also possible to request provisional entry of the assignment in R2 Plan. The coordination can be continued after the 8-year regulatory period.
- The provisions § 4.1.18, § 4.2.21A and § 6.25 cannot be applied in respect of entries in the Plans.
- Notifying Administration shall file a commitment in case that harmful/unacceptable interference is caused to the incumbent assignment.

Part B Technical Exam and Publication

In order to ensure compatibility, the BR uses the final characteristics in checking:

- Compliance with hard limits
- For AP30/30A, analysis changes as a result of seeking agreement.
- Missing Agreements
 - Any still affected administrations without an agreement?
 - Provisional entry into the List possible? (For AP30B and R1/3 AP30/30A)
 - Examination of the “more interference” arising from the change of characteristics from Part A, is caused to existing networks before receipt of this Part B

Radiocommunication Bureau Notes

1. Based on the request received by the Radiocommunication Bureau under § 4.1.12 of Article 4 of Appendix **30** to the Radio Regulations, this Special Section is published in accordance with § 4.1.15 of Article 4 of Appendix **30**.
2. The frequency assignments of the subject satellite network submitted under § 4.1.3 of Appendix 30 were published in the following Special Section(s):

- AP30/E/762 (Part A) annexed to BR IFIC No. 2851 of 08.08.2017
3. In application of the criteria of Annex 1 to Appendix **30**, taking into account the final characteristics provided by the notifying Administration as published in this Special Section, the Bureau has reviewed the list of administrations whose agreements are required for completion of the Article 4 procedure for the subject network. The results of these examinations indicate that the services of 3 administration(s) whose agreement was not reached under § 4.1.12, are identified as affected. The notifying Administration has therefore requested for the application of § 4.1.18. In addition, there is no administration whose services are newly identified as affected as a result of these modifications to the initial submission, in accordance with § 4.1.11.
4. In view of the above, the Bureau, pursuant to § 4.1.15 of Appendix **30**, concludes that the Article 4 procedure for the subject satellite network has been successfully completed. In accordance with § 4.1.18 and 4.1.18bis of the same Appendix, the subject assignments are therefore provisionally included in the List and the Reference Situation of the Regions 1 and 3 Plan and List and of other Article 4 submissions, which are still at the stage of application of that Article, has been updated except for those assignments which are the basis for the disagreement.

Check of missing agreement

3. Taking into account the final characteristics and agreements with other administration(s) provided by the notifying administration as published in this Special Section, the Bureau has examined the submission under § 6.19, 6.21 and 6.22 of Appendix **30B**. The agreements of those administrations whose territories are included in the service areas of the subject network are obtained. The results of examination under § 6.21 of Appendix **30B** indicate that assignments of other administration(s) that did not communicate an agreement are identified as affected. Therefore, the Bureau returns the subject submission pursuant to §6.24 of Appendix **30B**.

4. As the notifying Administration requested the application of §6.25 of Appendix **30B** and provided the commitment required in §6.26 of that Appendix, the assignments of the subject network are provisionally included in the List in accordance with §6.25 of Appendix **30B**. Accordingly, the Reference Situation of allotments in the Plan, the assignments in the List and the assignments of other Article 6 submissions, which are still at the stage of application of that Article, has been updated, except for those assignments which are the basis for the unfavourable finding under §6.21 of Appendix **30B**.

Entry and provisional entry into the List

Notification and bringing into use, Res.49 and Res.40

- Notification with data in accordance with AP4 shall be submitted within the 8-year regulatory limit, and other regulatory provisions governing time limits (e.g. § 5.1.3 of AP30/30A and § 8.1 of AP30B) in the Appendices apply. (A dedicated session in this WRS on [Notification of Planned Services](#))
- Submission of date of bringing into use, which shall be within the 8-year regulatory period, unless an extension is granted.
- Res.49 shall be submitted within the 8-year plus 30 days limit.
- Res.40 shall be submitted together with the confirmation of bringing into use.
