WRC-19 Outcome 1

The Bureau reported difficulties in treating consistently the coordination status information that is provided in cover letters of administration during the notification of their satellite networks to WRC-19

Tool developed for administrations to communicate coordination status in relation to affected administrations at group level

Communicated in CR/483 dated 25 March 2022

Implemented in BR IFIC 2968 in April 2022



WRC-19 Outcome 2

When carrying out examination under RR No. **11.32A** to also take into account coordination agreement status with satellite networks of affected administrations <u>at notice level</u> when such information is provided for the notification of geostationary satellite networks, so that the notifying administration may benefit from the coordination agreements already obtained.

This information is optional

Implemented in BR IFIC 2945 in May 2021



CR/483 dated 25 March 2022

For notifications or resubmissions received from 1 July 2022, the BR will
not take into account in the examination of the notices any additional
information provided in cover letters relating to the status of coordination
agreements.


• Resubmission of a notification notice will not be considered receivable if it is not submitted through the e-Submission system.

Features of the tool to update coordination status




- Wizards implemented within the BR software SPACECAP
- User friendly interface
 - filters to facilitate maneuverability in notice to capture the coordination status with affected administrations at group level
- Coordination requirements retrieved for more accurate reporting
 - First notification
 - Coordination Request Notice
 - Resubmission
 - Notice returned and published under Part-3S
- Check if coordination requirements is still valid with an affected administration





Wizard includes check if coordination requirement is still valid with an affected administration

Implementation





Treatment of agreement status with an affected administration at group level



- If the "agreement obtained" status is indicated with an affected administration, the Bureau will
 - consider the coordination procedure has been completed with that administration
 - will not determine whether the satellite networks of the other administration have been suppressed or not
 - give a favourable finding under No.11.32
- If <u>no</u> "agreement obtained" is indicated with respect to an affected administration, the Bureau will
 - consider that coordination has not been obtained with that administration
 - carry out examination to check if there is still coordination requirement with that administration
 - consider that coordination has not been completed with that administration if there
 is still coordination requirement, and an unfavourable finding under No.11.32 will
 be given.

Group Level Agreement Tool User Interface and Features

- Layout of information in the Group Level Agreement table
 - General Information on top
 - Provisions tabs
 - Grouping of information
- Add and remove administration not listed as affected feature
- Administration indicated with an asterisk (no longer affected)

- Capturing Coordination information
 - Groups with affected and not affected administrations
 - Vertical agreement Fill
 - Horizontal agreement Fill
 - Beam Level agreement Fill
 - Agreement all groups Fill


- Filter Features
 - Using filter tool to capture coordination agreements
 - beam, the direction of transmission, group id nos., min and max frequencies, service area no. or combination of these parameters
 - Clear filter
- Save Captured Agreements




DEMO Capture of Satellite Network List
