## **SRS-Removal**

## Information regarding the process of removal of obsolete information on the Advance Publication Information (API) and coordination requests from the Space Radiocommunications Stations database

The Radiocommunication Bureau through its Circular Letter CR/377 (27.01.2105) has informed administrations on the process of the removal from the Space Radiocommunications Stations (SRSxxxx.mdb) database distributed in the BR IFIC (Space services) of obsolete information related to Advance Publication Information (API) and requests for coordination of satellite networks for which the regulatory period specified under Nos. **11.44** and **11.44.1** has expired and for which the frequency assignments have partly or wholly been recorded in the Master International Frequency Register (MIFR).

The list of removed **Advance Publication Information** and **Coordination Requests** with a date of receipt no later than 1 January 2008 is attached to this note and also published on the Bureau website.

This note provides the details of this process of removal which involves transferring of the date of receipt of the assignments in the removed coordination request to the notification.

The date of protection of the assignments in coordination request (2D\_C\_Date) is transferred to corresponding assignments of the notification into the existing '2D Date' data element (SRS data element - d\_prot\_eff).

The new data element, 2D\_N\_Date - date of receipt of the first notification, is established containing previously recorded '2D Date' of the assignments in the notification. This data element is maintained in the table fdg\_ref (see BR Space Preface).

The initial orbital location and the date of receipt of API are transferred to the corresponding data items (long\_orig and api\_d\_rcv).

For the networks not subject to coordination, '2D Date' in the notification is maintained unchanged.

For coordination transactions having date of protection not later than 01.01.2001, a single 2D\_C\_Date of 01.01.1900 is established for the corresponding notification groups in order not to change the protection afforded to these assignments with respect to later submissions. In this way all assignments recorded in the MIFR whose corresponding coordination transactions have date of receipt not later than 01.01.2001 will be taken into account in the examinations of notifications submitted after 01.01.2015. In future, if priority needs to be established between the assignments falling under this category, the Bureau would undertake to establish the actual 2D\_C Date of the assignments.

For the groups received after 01.01.2001 the actual 2D\_C\_Date is established and taken into account in the examinations as mentioned above.
