

BR IFIC SPACE SERVICES USER GUIDE

The BR IFIC Space Services is a service publication published every two weeks by the Radiocommunication Bureau in accordance with provision Nos. 20.1-20.6 and No. 20.15 of the Radio Regulations.

The BR IFIC Space Services is published in DVD-ROM and ISO file. Further, from BRIFIC 2987 (10.01.2023), it is also published on a web application: the BR IFIC Space services Online, available at the following URL: https://www.itu.int/epublications/brific-space

This document provides explanation on this web application and on the desktop application.

1. User access to the BR IFIC online

The BR IFIC (Space services) is a paying service which can be subscribed to by contacting the Sales Department (sales@itu.int).

Further, each Administration and each subscriber to the BR IFIC DVD-ROM have been invited to assign some designated users, per DVD subscription, for free online access.

2. BR IFIC availability

The BR IFIC (Space services) publications are available on the online application from BR IFIC 2987 dated 10 January 2023.

Previously published BR IFIC are only available on DVD-ROM or ISO file and may be requested by contacting the Sales Department (sales@itu.int).

3. Desktop application (ISO FILE)



The ISO file, to install the desktop application, is available for download in the BRIFIC online. This desktop application provides the same functionalities as the online application, at the exception of the Advanced queries which are only available online. (See section 11 for more information).


4. Your subscriptions



The list of BR IFIC available is available from the menu [Home].

The user <u>should select a specific BR IFIC</u> to have access to the different items in the menu and to browse its content.

5. Highlights



The Highlights are available from the menu [Home], below the list of BR IFIC.

Highlights are News where the BR inform users of the BR IFIC, Corrections of incorrectly published information, general modification such as Change of satellite name or Change of Operating agency.



6. Publications on the BRIFIC online



The list of Publications is available from the menu [Publications] and can be exported in csv format.

The Bureau publishes the Special sections and Parts on PDF files (regulatory publications).

These files can be downloaded by <u>double clicking</u> the corresponding line or by <u>clicking on the PDF icon</u> on the list of Publications.



Together with the regulatory publications, the Bureau is also publishing the relevant technical data.

These data are the following:

- Result of Appendix 8 Examination of GSO Satellite networks for non-Planned satellite services (AP8 result)
- Data for Article 22 examination with respect to compliance with EPFD limits

- MSPACEg output database for Appendix 30/30A Article 4 Part A (AP30 30A result)
- GIBC/PFD (terrestrial) technical examination results for Appendix 30/30A Article 4 Part A (AP30_30A PFD)
- GIBC/PFD (terrestrial) technical examination results for Article 2A network (AP30_30A PFD)
- GIBC/AP30B output database for Appendix 30B pending Article 6 network (AP30B result)
- Interference analysis (Interference analysis)

Please note that not all regulatory publications are linked to technical data.


All the regulatory publications and technical data can be downloaded from the list of Publications via the Publication cards or by downloading items as a zip.




6.1. Publication cards

By clicking on the icon [Publication Card], the [BR IFIC - space – Publication] card pops up, displaying the corresponding regulatory publication and all technical data available for this publication. All the relevant files can be downloaded from this publication card.

The structure of the download zip file is the following:




7. Databases



The Bureau publishes in this section the latest version of the different databases. For each database, an explanation and a download button with the indication of its size is available.




Files providing information on the different database are also available in this section.






8. Other data

9. Advanced queries




Please note that the queries are not available on the desktop application, the BR software BRSIS-SpaceQry should be run on a local PC.

Queries on the data of the publications are developed in this menu.

The queries are limited to the non-planned bands and to the data published in the relevant BRIFIC. In case of a modification, the queries will take into account only the modified data.

The queries do not take into account general publications, such as bringing into use, suspension, suppression, etc..., which do not modify the interfering situation.

9.1. Affected administrations




By selecting a satellite network, the query displays the list of affected Administrations.

- Type a satellite name and click on [Search satellite] to display the relevant publication and the list of affected administrations.

Only publications of the relevant BRIFIC which modified the list of affected Administrations can be selected.



9.2. Affected networks




By selecting a satellite network, the query displays the list of affected networks.

- Type a satellite name and click on [Search satellite] to display the relevant publication and the list of affected networks.

Only publications of the relevant BRIFIC which modified the list of affected networks can be selected.



9.3. Interfering networks



By selecting an Administration / Intergovernmental Organization satellite network, the query displays the list of networks interfering with the Administration.

- Type an Administration and (Intergovernmental Organization) and click on [Search] to display the list of interfering networks.

Only Administrations identified in a publication of the relevant BRIFIC can be selected.

Only publications which modify the interference situation are displayed.


11. ISO file and DVD-ROM
