Uwe Schwark was born in Bremen, Germany, on July 9, 1970. He received the Dipl.-Ing. (FH) degree in Communications Engineering from the University of Applied Sciences Bremen in 1997. His professional career started in the wireless communications industry. Since December 2012 he is also the acting CEPT coordinator for this agenda item.
