Mr. Fatih Mehmet Yurdal is the director of Bolt& Yurdal Consulting ApS in Denmark. He is also the chairman of the WG1 of ITU-R WP1B, responsible for the Short Range Devices. He graduated as BSc in Physics Engineering from Hacettepe University in Turkey and obtained MSc degree in Satellitte Communications Engineering from the University of Surrey in the UK. He worked several years in various posts for the National Radiocommunications Regulatory Agency of Turkey ending up with the post of Deputy Director General responsible for international regulatory matters.

In 1999, Mr. Yurdal was appointed as the CEO and Director General of Turk Telekom, the incumbent Telecom operator of Turkey.
