Subject: Special Section GE06/13

The Radiocommunication Bureau informs that the BR IFIC 2615 contains **Special Section GE06/13** related to broadcasting service in GE06 planning area and bands.

Following the special arrangements related to the processing and publication of notices concerning the **GE06 agreement**, please note that **Special Section GE06/13** is presented as follows:

- *Part A1: 35 digital broadcasting assignments that can be consulted using the “GE06 Interface” software.*
- *Part B1: 151 digital broadcasting assignments that can be consulted using the “GE06 Interface” software.*
- *Part A2: 129 analogue broadcasting assignments that can be consulted using the “GE06 Interface” or “TerraQ” software.*
- *Part B2: 3 analogue broadcasting assignments that can be consulted using the “GE06 Interface” or “TerraQ” software.*

Subject: Processing error in Special Section GE06/13

This information concerns the administrations of Albania, Algeria, Greece, Libya, Niger, Nigeria, Serbia and Ukraine.

The Special Section GE06/13 contains erroneous information that indicated that the administrations of Albania, Algeria, Greece, Libya, Niger, Nigeria and Serbia were identified as potentially affected with respect to ten (10) proposed modifications to the GE06 Plan submitted by the administration of Ukraine, due to a processing error.

The error was corrected and the process of identifying potentially affected administrations has been rerun. It is confirmed that the above administrations are NO LONGER identified as potentially affected by these proposed modifications.
