

3) Partition of Netherlands Antilles "ATN"

As from issue 2717 of 17 April 2012, the BR IFIC (Terrestrial services) will reflect the changes related to the replacement of the geographical area "ATN" the Netherland Antilles by three new geographical areas "CUW" for Curaçao, "SXM" for St. Maarten (Dutch part) and "BES" for the islands Bonaire, St. Eustatius and Saba to comply with the request of the Administration of the Netherlands.

The following updates have been made by the Bureau in its databases and documents:

- For those assignments in the Master Register (MIFR) and the frequency assignment plan associated with the Regional Agreement RJ81, which have symbol "ATN" as the geographical area of a transmitting station, this symbol has been replaced by symbol "CUW" or symbol "SXM" or symbol "BES" depending on the geographical coordinates of the station concerned.
- For those assignments in the MIFR, which had symbol "ATN" as the receiving service area, this receiving service area "ATN" has been replaced by three receiving areas "CUW", "SXM" and "BES" in each assignment.
- The symbol "ATN in the AP25 and AP26 plans has been replaced by the three new symbols "CUW", "SXM" and "BES" for each entry appearing in these plans.
- The symbol "ATN" has been replaced by the three new symbols "CUW", "SXM" and "BES" in the table of Geographical areas of the Preface to the BR IFIC (Chapter IV, Section 2) and the table of Address Codes and Operating Agencies has been updated accordingly (Chapter IV, Section 3).
