3) Test version of the BR IFIC (Terrestrial Services) in new format

As from BR IFIC No. 2719, together with the distribution of the regular BR IFIC DVD, the ITU is issuing another DVD containing a test version of the BR IFIC using a new format.

The database management system is being changed and consequently the programs TerRaQ, TerRaNotices and TerRaNV were revised. You are kindly invited to test this new BR IFIC DVD and submit your comments and suggestions by e-mail to brmail@itu.int.

With this new BR IFIC DVD, the user does not need to:

- perform any specific installation to browse the BR IFIC content;
- have administrator privilege for using/installing the BR IFIC;
- adjust Windows security settings to install the database;
- · have licenses for using the database.

In addition, the tests conducted by the Bureau show also that the new BR IFIC DVD is fully compatible with Windows 7.

Some of the new features of the BR IFIC DVD are:

- a new "navigation menu" in a "plug-and-play" mode, which allows the user to browse the data, perform queries, execute one of the above mentioned software packages, directly from the DVD without the need to perform any installation;
- an "install-on-demand" utility, which allows the user to install the BR IFIC data and/or its software packages.
