3) Partition of the ITU Member State “Sudan (Republic of the)”

As from edition 2724 of 24 July 2012, the BR IFIC (Terrestrial services) will reflect the changes related to the partition of the ITU Member State “Sudan (Republic of the)” into two separate States, Republic of the Sudan (SDN) and Republic of South Sudan (SSD).

The following updates have been made by the Bureau in its databases and documentation:

- **GLAD (Global Administrative Data Base):** In addition to the existing geographical area codes “SDN” and “SSD” new code “XBY” for Abyei area has been inserted. Administrations “XZZ”, “SDN” and “SSD” are designated as responsible administrations for geographical area “XBY” in order to allow the notifications from SDN and SSD Administrations in Abyei area.
- **IDWM (ITU Digital World Map):** The UN maps boundaries for geographical areas “SDN”, “SSD” and “XBY” has been incorporated into IDWM and geographical area “XSD” deleted.
- **Master Register (MIFR) and Plans:** For those assignments in the MIFR and Plans associated with the Regional Agreements GE75, GE84 and GE06 which have symbol “SDN” as the geographical area, this symbol has been kept or replaced by symbol “SSD” or symbol “XBY” depending on the geographical coordinates of the station concerned. In addition, symbol “SDN” as the Administration has been kept or replaced by symbol “SSD” or symbol “XZZ” depending on the location of the transmitting station.
- **Preface to the BRIFIC:** The symbol “XBY” has been added in the Tables of Geographical Areas (see Chapter IV, Section 2) and the addresses of the administrations of SDN and SSD have been added to the Tables of Address Codes and Operating Agencies for geographical area “XBY” (see Chapter IV, Section 3).
