#### **Establishment & Main Mission**

- WTSA Resolution 55 "Mainstreaming a gender perspective in ITU Telecommunication Standardization Sector activities" (Rev. Dubai, 2012) instructed the TSB Director to "conduct research to identify women in standardization, with a goal of creating an ITU-T Women in Standardization Group"
- The ITU Women in Standardization Expert Group (WISE) was created at the TSAG meeting in February 2016
- In late 2022, the group was rebranded as NoW in ITU-T to align with the other ITU Sectors



Making the world of standardization and telecommunications/ICTs development attractive to women through providing opportunities for women to learn, connect and advance their careers



### **Objectives**



- Promoting women's engagement in ITU activities, the standardization sector, the WTSA and beyond
- Advocating for women in leadership positions + championing their career advancement in the ICT industry and supporting standardization activities

- Recognizing achievements + generating resources for women from developing countries, to cultivate diverse leadership talent








**Network of Women at WTSA-24**
