- Created following ISO/IEC/ITU-T Joint Task Force on effective collaboration (JTFEC)
- Approved by the ISO/TMB, IEC/SMB and ITU-TSAG
- Operational in 2019, and has met 11 times since (10 virtual, one F2F meeting)
- Vision Coordinated and coherent international standards landscape
- Close link with WSC

Role of SPCG

- Need to coordinate existing and future standardization work
- Innovation is accelerating and technologies are converging
- Standards need to be coherent, and not in conflict / duplicated, if they are to be adopted
- Coordination will reduce burdens on standard makers and users









Coordination of new activities

- Review new fields of work
- Identifies interest of the other organizations
- Collects views of its members
- Develops a recommendation to the Board (or informally report its findings)
- 30 proposals have been considered so far; six SPCG recommendations have been filed to the Boards.
- Follow-up and tracking process established for reactions/decisions of the Boards.











- Need to understand where existing IEC / ISO / ITU-T coordination is taking place and how effective it is
- SPCG has mapped the standards landscape to identify areas of coordination across the three organisations

Landscape of existing areas

- Some 50+ fields of common interest have been identified
- Objective is to prioritize areas of work that would require extra support on coordination
- Planned trial in one specific area Artificial Intelligence
- Lessons learnt will be applied to other areas







Cooperation with IEC-ISO-ITU J-Smart City Task Force (J-SCTF)

- J-SCTF to report to SPCG before going to the three Boards
- Aim to facilitate coordination of Smart Cities-related developments across the three organizations
- SPCG to provide guidance to J-SCTF
- SPCG to learn lessons from J-SCTF
- Ultimately, work closer together to achieve the common goals




