

American Community Survey (ACS)




Limited English Proficient (LEP)

LEP Dot Density



Drivers to Implement Automated Translations

- <u>Executive Order 13166</u> Limited English Proficiency (2000)
- NWS CaRDS requirement 16-008: "Products and Services in support of Limited English Proficiency (LEP) and building a Weather-Ready Nation" (2016)
- <u>Executive Order 13985</u> Underserved Communities (2021)
- NWS San Juan asks for assistance in translating NHC products. NWS
 CP investigates translation automation in Spanish (2021)
- Remnants of Hurricane Ida causes Asian deaths in NY (2021)
- NY AG Call for Language Accessibility in Weather Alerts (2022)
- NOAA <u>FY23 Congressional Appropriations bill</u> calling to expand efforts in translation of weather alerts (2022)
- NWS Ida Service Assessment released and is the first time NWS identifies service equity in a service assessment (2023)

Language from the FY23 NOAA Appropriations Bill:

"Weather Alerts.—The Committee appreciates the steps taken by NWS to provide Spanish translation of their weather products. However, more steps must be taken to ensure that all weather forecast and warning products can be understood by limited English proficiency individuals. Therefore, NOAA is directed, within the increases provided for NWS, to expand these efforts. Further, no later than 90 days after the enactment of this Act, the Committee directs NWS to submit a plan and timeline for how it will provide translation of all its weather products and warnings, not just for Spanish, but for the main dialects of other commonly used languages, considering both the number of speakers and the density of those speakers in various geographic locations. The Committee expects the fiscal year 2024 budget request to include additional funding for this purpose."

Al Translation Objectives & Requirements

Availability:

- Critical weather information in a variety of languages
- Support for NWS offices without bi-lingual forecasters
- Wide access to the products (web, radio, WEA, API, etc)



Efficient:

- Near real time translation (A translated TOR does no good if it takes 15 min to translate)
- Reduce burden of translation workload on bi-lingual forecasters



Scalable:

- NWS has many bi-ligual Spanish experts, but what about **unresourced languages** like Chinese, Vietnamese, etc...
- Train models on a variety of weather types across different locales via a "Balanced Diet" of English products
- Account for different dialects and words that do not have one for one translations













3 Layers of Language Model Adaptation

LLM Training Strategy

- "Balanced Diet" of Wx messaging

- Multilingual Glossary
- Existing corpus? Cleanup!


2021: 9,000 instances of "training the model to do something you **don't** want" in 44,000 corpus sentences

186 passages with variables (e.g. wind speed, rainfall range)















NWS Watches

Occasionally the model translates "watch" as "reloj" which means "clock" or "wristwatch" in Spanish as opposed to the correct term of "vigilancia" which means "surveillance or to be watchful"

Snow Accumulations

- The word "accumulations" was translated as "acusaciones" (which in Spanish means accusations). It should be "acumulaciones"
 - Additional snow accumulations of two to four inches above 10000 feet.

Troughs/Trofs

Sometimes the translation for "trough" comes out as "el comedero" or "el abrevadero" which is a trough that farm animals eat or drink from instead of the meteorological term "vaguada" for "pressure troughs".

Small Craft Advisory

For Small Craft Advisories, Lilt interpreted "Small Craft" as "small pieces of art"



Tornado

Before being trained properly, **Tornado** Warning

somehow translated to... *Torpedo* Warning!



Waterspout

"Waterspout" is incorrectly translated to "tornado". Elsewhere in the product "waterspout" is translated as either "water tornado" or "sea tornado", both of which are more accurate than just "tornado".

Weather Spotters



The word "**spotter**" in the Chinese was translated to "**sounder**". We've also seen instances of translations to "**trained detective**". We're probably looking for the equivalent of "**observer**".







Planned Future Capabilities

- Incorporate translated text, and broadcast over NOAA Weather Radio with existing infrastructure
- NWS-wide automated Spanish Al translations via Google Drive drop folder
- 3 Al driven Twitter/X posts in Chinese + more languages to come
- 4 Spanish CAP format pave the way for more languages translated in WEA messages
- 5 Al translation eventual integration into weather.gov 2.0 website re-vamp
