

STEP 1: PARTICIPANTS WHO <u>DO NOT</u> HAVE AN ACTIVE ITU ACCOUNT:

Go to ITU User Account login page: https://user.itu.int/ and at the bottom of that page, click "here" on No ITU Account yet? Click here to create one. This will bring you to the "ITU User account creation" page.

- 2. Fill in the Contact data (left side panel). If your e-mail account is already registered in the system, it most likely means that you already have an ITU account. If you don't remember the password, please follow the steps to reset your password.
- 3. For Organization data, pick the applicable type or organization



The "I don't know" option will let you explore the list of existing members, in case you represent a member and you are not aware of it.

ONLY in the case you **cannot** find your organization in the database, follow the link to enter information of your organization (link just below the Country drop-down list).
