



Mr. Charles Kerua is an economist by profession. He graduated with a bachelor's degree in economics and later a post graduate diploma in Science majoring statistics and mathematics, both at the University of Papua New Guinea. Apart from taking up part-time teaching positions at the University of Papua New Guinea for few years, he spent most of his career at the National ICT Authority of Papua New Guinea (NICTA). Currently serving as the senior economist within the Economics branch of NICTA, Mr. Kerua is responsible for activities relating to economic regulation such as retail and wholesale tariff regulation, wholesale access and sharing, interconnection and competition issues, among others. In addition to his role within NICTA, he engages with the International Telecommunications Union (ITU) representing NICTA in the ITU-T sector meetings in his capacity as the Vice-Chairman of the ITU-T Study Group 3 Regional Group of the Asia and Oceania region.
