The International Telecommunication Union (ITU), together with the Municipality of Montevideo (IMM), the Inter-American Association of Telecommunication Enterprises (ASIET), the Economic Commission for Latin American and the Caribbean (ECLAC), the Basel Convention Regional Centre for the South American Region (CRBAS) and the Development Bank of Latin America (CAF), is organizing the sixth edition of the Green Standards Week, from 5 to 9 September 2016 in Montevideo, Uruguay.

This year, the Green Standards Week is dedicated to the theme of "Shaping Smart Sustainable Cities: Towards Habitat III", and will be kindly hosted by the Municipality of Montevideo, Uruguay.

- 2 The Green Standards Week 2016 will be structured as follows:
  - II Meeting of "Smart Cities for inclusion and sustainability", to be held from 5 to 7 September 2016;
  - XVII Ibero-American Meeting of Digital Cities, to be held on 8 September 2016;
  - Forum on "Building the Cities We Want: Connecting the Dots for the New Urban Agenda", to be held on 9 September 2016 (morning).
- 3 The Green Standards Week acts as global platform for discussion and knowledge-sharing in order to raise awareness of the importance of and opportunities for using information and communication technologies (ICTs) to protect the environment and expedite the transition to smart sustainable cities.
- The Green Standards Week brings together leading specialists in the field, from top policy-makers to engineers, designers, smart city planners, government officials, regulators, standards experts, academia and others.
- 5 Discussions will be held in English and Spanish.

- Participation is open to ITU Member States, Sector Members, Associates and Academic Institutions and to anyone who wishes to contribute to the work. This includes individuals who are also members of international, regional and national organizations. Participation in these events is free of charge.
