- The United Arab Emirates, Qatar and Saudi Arabia are regional leaders in the NRI 2020
- Leading the region are the United Arab Emirates (30th), (38th) and Saudi Qatar Arabia (41st), with the region's major other economies like Jordan and Egypt ranked at 84th and 69th, respectively.
- The region's lowest-ranking economy is Yemen, in 132rd place.

• In January 2021, the internet users reached 4.66 billion of the global population – 59.5%

 In the Arab region : about 55% of the population

· Connectivity divide between urban and rural areas: in the Arab region: urban areas: 74% | Rural areas: 38%
