Self-Verified DNS Reverse Resolution

- ❑ Domain Name System (DNS) reverse resolution is relied on by anti-spam techniques to verify the e-mail origins and by measurements or applications to uncover the host information.
- ❑ An explicit scheme is proposed to enable automatical resolution and verification by DNS cache servers and significantly cut the number of queries and response.
