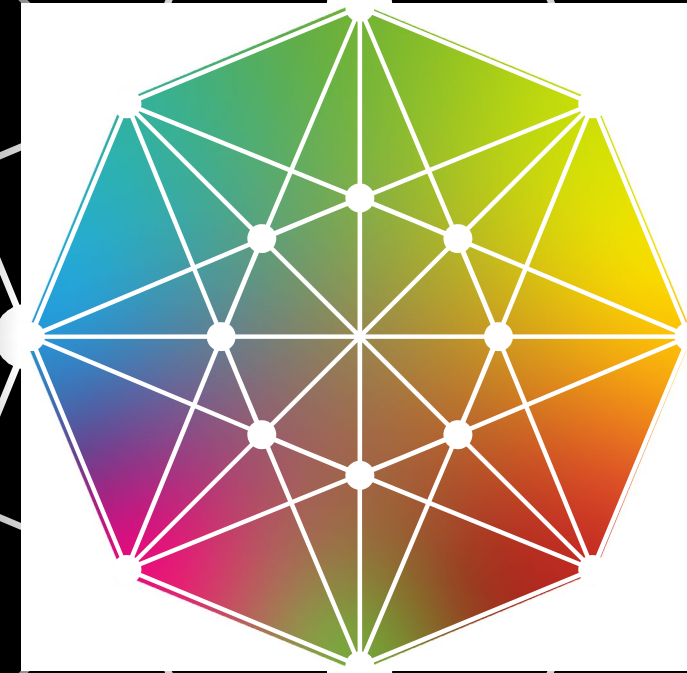

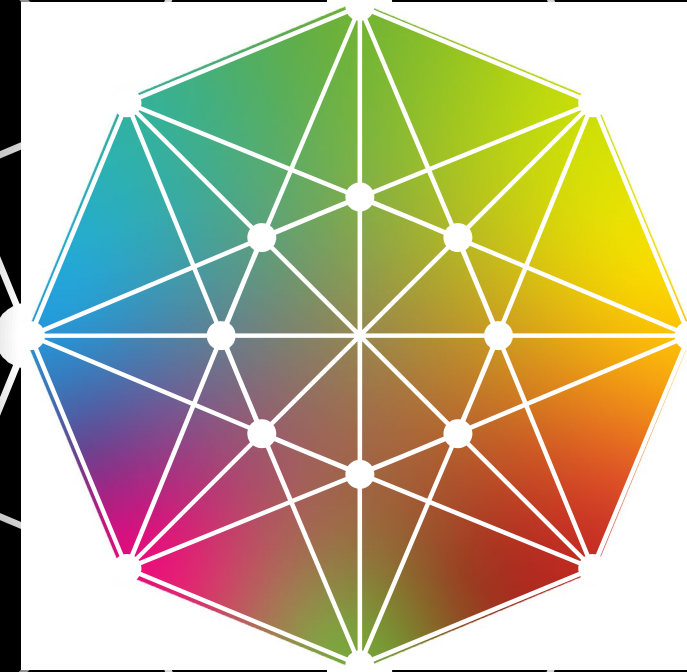

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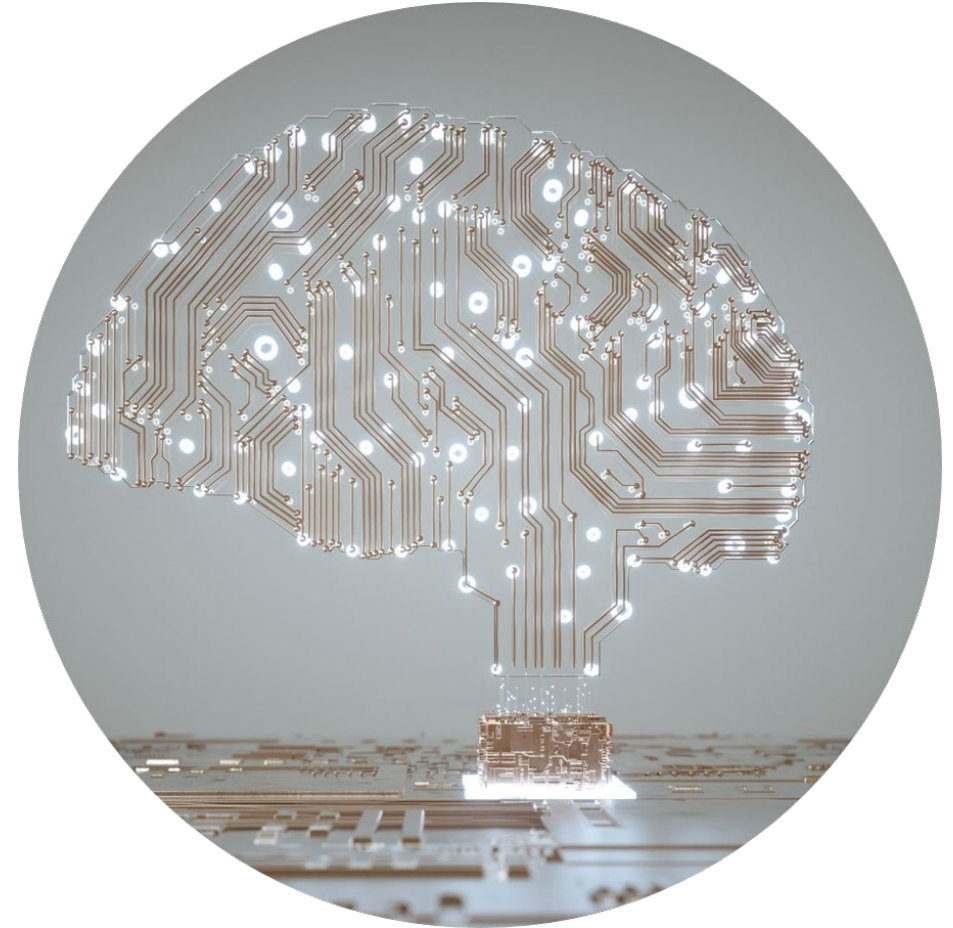

Artificial General Intelligence (AGI)

- AGI = human-level intelligence across domains
- Broader than today's narrow AI tools
- Generative AI moving closer to AGI
- AGI is not public yet, but development is accelerating
- Key question: Will AGI support collective wellbeing?



Public Perceptions

- Mixed public opinions, strong concerns
- Concerns around jobs, privacy, safety, and relationships
- AI already used in sensitive areas
- Trust depends on safety and accountability



Policy Framework

- AGI governance is fragmented
- Companies set their own safety standards
- Global frameworks call for international coordination, transparency, oversight, inclusion, and ethical innovation.
- US policy emphasizes innovation and leadership
- Policy protections not keeping pace with tech innovation



Role of Social Workers in AGI Landscape



- Bring a human-centered lens
- Connect people, communities, and systems
- Identify risks and inequalities
- Support ethical oversight
- Social work values guide responsible AGI

Create global vulnerability mapping



Integrate social workers into AI innovation and governance
