2. Transportation and site information

Thanks to its proximity to several public transportation stations, Tor Vergata University can be easily reach by car, by train from Roma Termini station and by main public transportation.

By Car: take Exit number 19-20 from the Grande Raccordo Anulare (GRA), the highway ring surrounding the city Direction: Romanina – 2°Università.

Main Public Transportation (Metro and Bus ticket cost 1,50 euro).

From Termini Station: take the subway **Metropolitana - Line "A" (Orange)** toward Anagnina (last stop). Once at Anagnina, take Bus number 20 Express to reach: Central Administration Offices, School of Law, **School of Economics**; Engineering; Humanities and Philosophy; Mathematical, Physical and Natural Sciences; Medicine and Surgery.

Metropolitana Linea "C": Get off at Torre Angela and take Bus 500, 506 and 20 Express *Cotral extra-urban lines*: Cotral services connect many municipalities of lower Lazio with the Anagnina underground station, crossing the university campus "Tor Vergata".

From Fiumicino Leonardo da Vinci Airport:

Take the Leonardo Express from Fiumicino Airport to Roma Termini (Rome main railway station). There you can catch the Metro Line A from Termini to Anagnina, getting off at the last stop, Anagnina (please see above)

Train from Fiumicino Airport Railway to Roma Tuscolana station, walk for 5 minutes to the Metro Line A stop, Ponte Lungo, take it toward Anagnina, and exit at the last stop, Anagnina.

Tor Vergata Shuttle BUS Service:

Tor Vergata offers two shuttle buses - Shuttle A & Shuttle B to help better reach the faculties and main university buildings. Itineraries and Schedules are available here.

3. Passports, visas and invitation letters

Citizens of EU and Schengen countries are required to present a valid passport or identification card.

Citizens from non-EU countries entering Italy must possess a passport valid for at least six months after their arrival date in Italy. Visitors from countries whose citizens require a visa should, at the earliest opportunity, and well in advance of travel, apply for a visa at an Italian Embassy.

You may need a letter of invitation from the Italian host, which you will have to present to the Embassy in your area in order to obtain your visa.

Upon request, Tor Vergata University will provide participants who are officially registered for the ITU-T SG5 meeting with an invitation letter in order to facilitate the processing of their visa applications. Applicants should address such requests, together with a scanned copy of their passport (pages with photo, date of issue and expiry date), as well as their occupation/position within their company/organization, to Tor Vergata University.

Before requesting the visa letter, experts must ensure that they are fully registered to the ITU-T SG5 meeting and that their registration request has been approved by the focal point of their organization.

The deadline for submitting your request to the Tor Vergata University for an invitation letter is 23 September 2022, at the latest.

4. Climate – during October

The climate in Rome during October can be summarized as warm but not hot, with an average temperature of 15°C and highs of 23°C. The temperature steadily lowers towards the end of the month to around 15°C. There are eight hours of sunshine per day, which is enough time to shop in the city centre and enjoy an afternoon of sightseeing and exploring.

On average, it will rain on 12 days of the month, with an expected total rainfall of around 94mm. The average sea temperature is 22°C – more than warm enough to enjoy a dip during your holiday!

Currency exchange:

The official currency accepted in Italy is the EURO. Major foreign currencies may be exchanged for EURO at hotels and foreign exchange banks. Official banking hours can vary slightly, but in general are from 8:30 a.m. until 1:30 p.m., and an hour and a half in the afternoon between 2:30 and 4:40. Banks are generally closed on weekends and holidays. Cash can be withdrawn easily 24/7 from the numerous ATMs spread in the city.

Most hotels, restaurants, car rental agencies, department stores and shops accept major credit cards (American Express, Diners Club, MasterCard, VISA). Usually, there is a sticker at the entrance indicating which cards are accepted.

Language: Italian is the official language in Italy, but English is widely understood in major hotels, restaurants, banks and businesses.

Rome, "Caput mundi", is the capital of Italy with over 2.7 million residents in 1,285.3 km² (496.3 sq. miles). Rome's metropolitan area is the second largest in Italy (after Milan), with some 3.7 million residents. The city is located in the central-western portion of the Italian Peninsula, on the Tiber River within the Lazio region of Italy.

INVITATION LETTER REQUEST INFORMATION

All foreign visitors entering Italy must have a valid passport. Visitors from countries whose citizens require a visa should, at the earliest opportunity, and well in advance of travel, apply for a visa at an Italian Embassy.

You may need a letter of invitation from the Italian host, which you will need to present to the Embassy in your area in order to obtain your visa. The visa must be requested as soon as possible from the office (Embassy or Consulate) representing Italy in your country or, if there is no such office in your country, from the one that is closest to your country of departure. In order to obtain the invitation letter, please:

- a) Provide the information below (please fill in electronically)
- b) Provide the electronic copy of your passport (full name, date of birth, nationality, passport number, valid date of passport, etc. must be seen clearly)
- c) Send as e-mail attachments to <u>andrea.appolloni@uniroma2.it</u> and copy <u>tsbsg5@itu.int</u> before 23 September 2022. Please mark as reference in the subject "Invitation letter request for ITU-T SG5 meeting".
