Here's how you can access the ITU Knowledge sharing Platform for Digital Finance Security:

Accessing the GitBook Workspace

- Step 1: Send a Request to Join the Platform: Email dfssecuritylab@itu.int with the subject line "Request to Access ITU Knowledge sharing Platform for Digital Finance Security." Include your name, title, organization, Country and a brief explanation of your interest in joining the workspace.
- **Step 2: Receive Approval and Invitation:** After your request is approved, you'll receive an invitation to join the GitBook workspace. Click the "Accept Invitation" button in the email.
- **Step 3: Sign Up or Sign In to GitBook:** If you don't have a GitBook account, sign up for one. If you do, sign in with your existing credentials.
- Step 4: Access the DFS Security Guidelines GitBook: After signing up or signing in, you'll be directed to the ITU DFS Security Guidelines GitBook workspace. Use the link in the invitation email to access the workspace.

- Step 7: Join the ITUDFSSecurity Slack Workspace: After signing up or signing in, you'll be automatically added to the ITUDFSSecurity Slack workspace.
