
To access all resources, you need an ITU user account (if you don't have one, create one [here](#)). For non-members please refer to the guidelines on page 2 on how to create an ITU user account.

### To subscribe to the Global Initiative's mailing list via MyWorkspace

Log in to [MyWorkspace](#) using your ITU user account, and select the "Mailing lists" app.

1. Type the key phrase, e.g., "aicommons", and click "search".
2. Click the "Subscribe" button:
  - a. Members will receive an email confirming their subscription.
  - b. Non-members have to be verified by the secretariat staff and will receive email confirmation once the request is approved.



## Creating an ITU user account for ITU non-members to engage in the work of the Global Initiative

### How to get started

An [ITU user account](#) is required to participate in the work of the Global Initiative on AI and Data Commons. Anyone who is from a [country that is a member of ITU](#) may create an ITU user account in order to register for events, access documents/resources and subscribe to mailing lists for the focus group.

### Not an ITU member? Don't have an account?

1. Visit the [ITU user account creation webpage](#) and select "I am a new user".
2. Select "Media and Other Organizations".
3. Click "Create".
4. You will then be guided through the process of providing contact information. Once completed, you will receive an e-mail requesting you to activate your ITU user account.
