

Creating an ITU user account for non-members to participate in ITU-T FG-AI4EE meetings

How to get started

An [ITU user account](#) is required to participate in the work of the ITU-T Focus Group on Environmental Efficiency for Artificial Intelligence and other Emerging Technologies (FG-AI4EE). Anyone from a [country that is a member of ITU](#) can create an ITU user account.

An ITU user account is required to register to any ITU meetings and events, access documents/resources and also subscribe to ITU mailing lists.

Not an ITU member? Don't have an account?

1. Go to the ITU User Account Login webpage at: <https://www.itu.int/en/ties-services/Pages/login.aspx>
2. Select "I am a new user"
3. Choose your Membership category. See Members directory [here](#). If your organization is not an ITU member please select "Non Member or I don't know"
4. Select your country and organization. You may type in the name of your organization if it does not appear in the drop-down menu.
5. Click "Continue" and fill out your personal information
6. Once your account is set-up, you will receive a confirmation email.
