

Register in advance at https://itu.int/go/giai4h/reg. You will need an ITU account.



Online participation

Online access to the meeting will be made exclusively via https://remote.itu.int (general); a filtered list is also available (click the screenshot below). Make sure to login using the same ITU account used for your registration, otherwise you will not be able to connect.

Since all registration requests need to be screened by the secretariat, participants are urged to **register well in advance** to avoid last minute difficulties.

Once logged in, scroll the list if needed until you see "Meeting of the Global Initiative on AI for Health". If you do not see it on the day of the meeting (check the sliding rule on the top of the window), it probably means that your registration has not yet been OKed by the secretariat or that you logged in with an ITU account different from the one you used to register for the meeting. You can join the session from 30 minutes prior to the start of the session: click the JOIN button on the right side. If the button is shaded out (not clickable), refresh the browser (e.g., Control+F5 in Windows PCs).

Visa entry regulations

For e-visa issuing, please visit the Singapore Immigration & Checkpoints Authority website, in particular the <u>conditions for entering the country</u>. Please complete, within three days **before** you arrive, your *SG Arrival Online Submission* at https://www.ica.gov.sg/enter-transit-depart/entering-singapore/sg-arrival-card.

How to get around in Singapore

<u>Public transport:</u> The <u>mass rapid transit (MRT)</u> network covers most parts of Singapore and is a convenient mode of travel.

The closest MRT station to the Centre for Life Sciences (CeLS) at NUS is <u>Kent Ridge MRT</u> Station (CC24) (Circle Line), a 10-minute walk from CeLS.

<u>Taxis</u> are also readily available. You can use the ride-sharing app **Grab** (similar to Uber).

Currency/credit cards

The local currency is the Singapore Dollar (SGD); however, USD can also be used.

Foreign visitors can exchange money at a *bureau de change* or withdraw from ATMs. Credit cards are also widely accepted in Singapore.


Power plugs and sockets

Singapore uses Type G power plugs and sockets, the same as the UK.

Plug Type: Type G (three rectangular prongs)

Voltage: 230VFrequency: 50Hz

If you are coming from the UK, you will not need an adapter. Otherwise, you will need a Type G adapter.



Telecom services for SIM cards

You can get a prepaid SIM card in Singapore for short-term use.

Where to buy

- At the airport
- **Telecom shops** Official stores of Singtel, StarHub, M1, etc.
- Convenience stores 7-Eleven, Cheers, FairPrice Xpress
- Online Some providers allow eSIM purchases

If your phone supports eSIM, you can buy a digital SIM from Singtel, Airalo, or Holafly before arriving.
