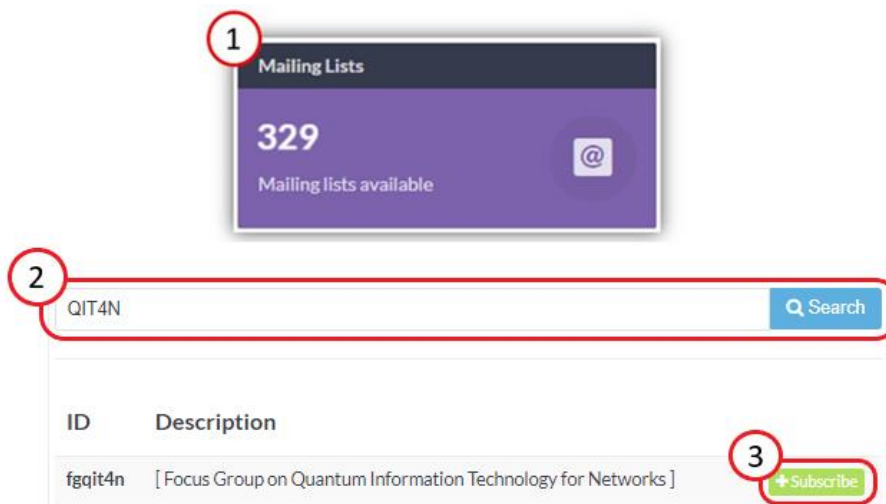
### To subscribe to the FG-QIT4N mailing list via MyWorkspace

Log in to [MyWorkspace](#) using your ITU user account, and select the "Mailing lists" app.

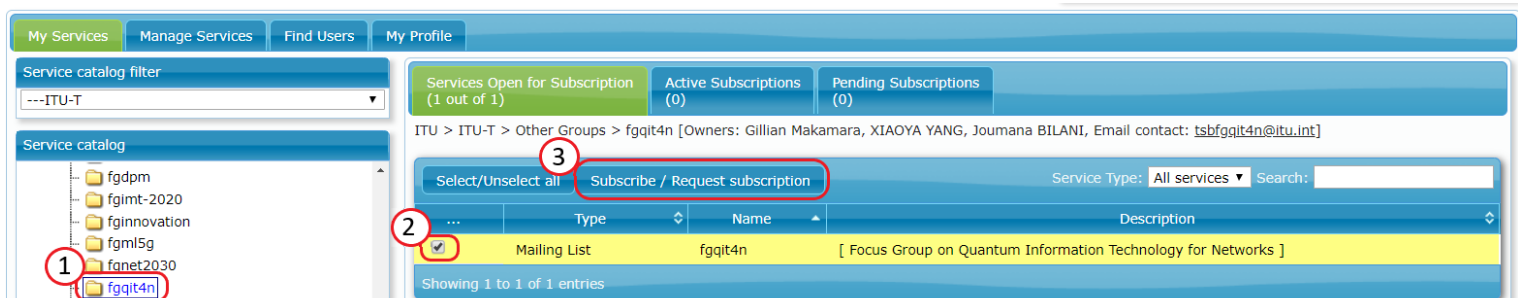
1. Type a key phrase, e.g., "QIT4N", and click "search".
2. Click the "Subscribe" button:
  - a. Members will receive an email confirming their subscription.
  - b. Non-members have to be verified by the secretariat staff, and will receive email confirmation once the request is approved.

### To subscribe to the FG-QIT4N mailing list via the traditional method

Log in to the traditional [mailing list webpage](#) using your ITU user account.



1. Select the "FG-QIT4N" folder.
2. Click on the mailing list checkbox.
3. Click the "Subscribe / Request subscription" button:
  - a. Members will receive an email confirming their subscription.
  - b. Non-members have to be verified by the secretariat staff, and will receive email confirmation once the request is approved.



## Creating an ITU user account for non-members to engage in the work of FG-QIT4N

### How to get started

An [ITU user account](#) is required to participate in the work of the ITU-T Focus Group on Quantum Information Technology for Networks (FG-QIT4N). Anyone who is from a [country that is a member of ITU](#) may create an ITU user account in order to register for events, access documents/resources and subscribe to mailing lists for the focus group.

### Not an ITU member? Don't have an account?

1. Visit the [ITU user account creation webpage](#) and select "I am a new user".
2. Select "Media and Other Organizations".
3. Click "Create".
4. You will then be guided through the process of providing contact information. Once completed, you will receive an e-mail requesting you to activate your ITU user account.
