- 1. On behalf of Giulio Maggiore (FG-TBFxG Chairman), we are pleased to announce that the seventh meeting of the ITU-T Focus Group on Testbeds Federations for IMT-2020 and beyond (FG-TBFxG) will be held fully virtually from 14 to 16 February 2024 at 1200-1600 hours Geneva time.
- 2. Working language: the discussions will be held in English only.
