1 Background

This Focus Group aims to analyse and identify gaps in the vehicular multimedia standardization landscape, and draft technical reports and specifications covering, among others, vehicular multimedia use cases, requirements, applications, interfaces, protocols, architectures and security. The extension of the tenure of FG-VM till the end of 2021 was approved by ITU-T Study Group 16 in July 2020.
