Malabo, Equatorial Guinea

1. Introduction

To facilitate your travel to Equatorial Guinea, please find below the visa application procedure for participants attending the SG5RG-AFR Meeting and related events.

2. Visa Application

Please note that the visa application process is completed **online** through the official portal:

https://equatorialguinea-evisa.com/

Important Information:

- Participants are strongly encouraged to apply as early as possible to ensure timely processing.
- The e-Visa is generally issued within 72 hours after submission.
- Please ensure that **all required documents** are uploaded and the application is **completed on the same day** it is initiated, to avoid technical delays.
- Visa fees are paid **online via the portal** (credit or debit card).

3. e-Visa fees

Visa fees for Equatorial Guinea vary depending on the type of visa and processing time, but common prices include \$75 for an **e-visa** (including a \$50 visa fee and \$25 service fee)

4. Exemptions

The following participants do not require a visa to enter Equatorial Guinea:

- Holders of United Nations Laissez-Passer (UNLP)
- Holders of **CEMAC passports** (from member states of the Economic and Monetary Community of Central Africa) ordinary and diplomatic passports
- Holders of passports from São Tomé and Príncipe

5. Required Documents for Online Application

The following documents are required for the online visa application:

- A valid passport (minimum 6 months validity)
- The official invitation letter (Collective letter 1/SG5RG-AFR)
- A round-trip flight ticket or travel itinerary
- **Proof of hotel booking** or accommodation letter (participants could either book via <u>booking.com</u> or request a confirmation directly from their hotel)
- Travel insurance
- A copy of the vaccination card (showing proof of Yellow Fever vaccination)
