Guidance on meetings

- Remote sessions will be organized with ITU MyMeetings, except for the joint ITU and ISO/IEC work and the Accessibility work, which will use Zoom.
- Registration for ITU-T SG16 meeting is mandatory at <https://www.itu.int/go/tsg16/reg>. You will **not be able to join** if not registered.
- Each session lasts 1.5 hours. Between virtual sessions, a break of 15 min is planned. Questions should not meet longer than 4 hours in a single day.
- All sessions are expected to end on time. Rapporteurs are invited to finish their Question meetings five minutes earlier to allow delegates to properly break and prepare for next virtual session. Delegates can join a session 30 minutes before its start, to ensure their working set up is properly configured.
- No "lunch break" is scheduled since it is meaningless for a distributed time-zone event.

General notes:

- The **SG16 and WP plenaries** will be held on Sessions 3, 4 and 5 to allow most participants to join.
- Joint video work with MPEG
 - **JVET** (aka ISO/IEC JTC1/SC 29/WG 5) will meet on 20-23 and 26-28 April 2021 (weekend sessions are not planned except for night sessions extending from the evening of 23 April).

- **JPEG** of ISO/IEC JTC1/SC 29 [WG 1] will meet virtually 19-23 April 2021, with some ad hoc sessions in the preceding week and weekend (12-18 April).
- **MPEG** of ISO/IEC JTC1/SC 29 [AGs 2, 3, 5 and WGs 2 to 8] will meet virtually 26-30 April 2021, with some AG 2 (coordination), WG 5 (JVET per above), WG 6 (audio) and ad hoc sessions in the preceding week and weekend (20-25 April).
