Agreement

- Draft new Technical Report ITU-T DSTR_OTTReporting “Establishing International Reporting Standards for OTT Applications” was agreed.
- Statement of the Administration of the United States: The United States disassociates from this Technical Report, which does not reflect the views of the U.S. Administration or align with U.S. interests.
