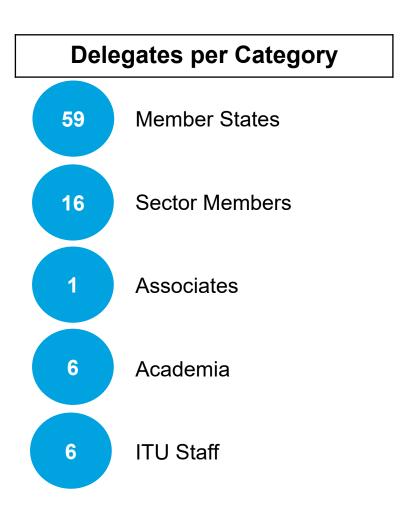

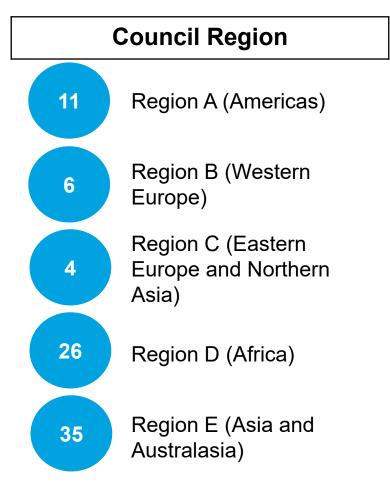
- Meeting of SG3 Regional Group for Asia and Oceania (SG3RG-AO) (New Delhi, India, 10-12 September 2025),

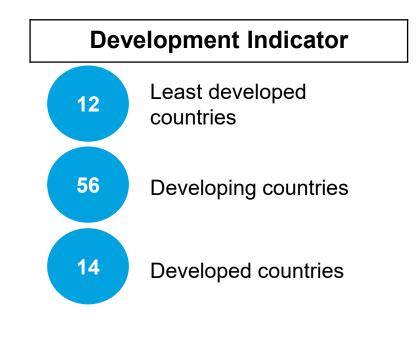
Remote participation, interpretation and webcast:

- Webcast was available for the Plenary meeting.


Participation Statistics

Approval

- New Recommendation ITU-T D.1142, Guidelines on economic and policy aspects of Internet of things (IoT) [link]
- In accordance with clause 9.5.6 of WTSA Resolution 1, the United States advised at the meeting that it is abstaining from the decision to apply the procedure.

Agreement

- Draft new Technical Report ITU-T DSTR_OTTReporting "Establishing International Reporting Standards for OTT Applications" was agreed.
- Statement of the Administration of the United States: The United States disassociates from this Technical Report, which does not reflect the views of the U.S. Administration or align with U.S. interests.

New work item initiated

• Draft new Technical Report <u>DSTR_TNOAI</u> "Enabling Environment for Voluntary Commercial Arrangements between Telecommunication Network Operators and Al Service Providers"

Focus Group on Cost Models for Affordable Data Services (FG-CD)

- The final progress report of Focus Group on Costing Models for Affordable Data Services (FG-CD) was presented
 in <u>SG3-TD77/PLEN</u>, providing a total of six deliverables to SG3.
- FG-CD has concluded its activities and is now considered closed.
