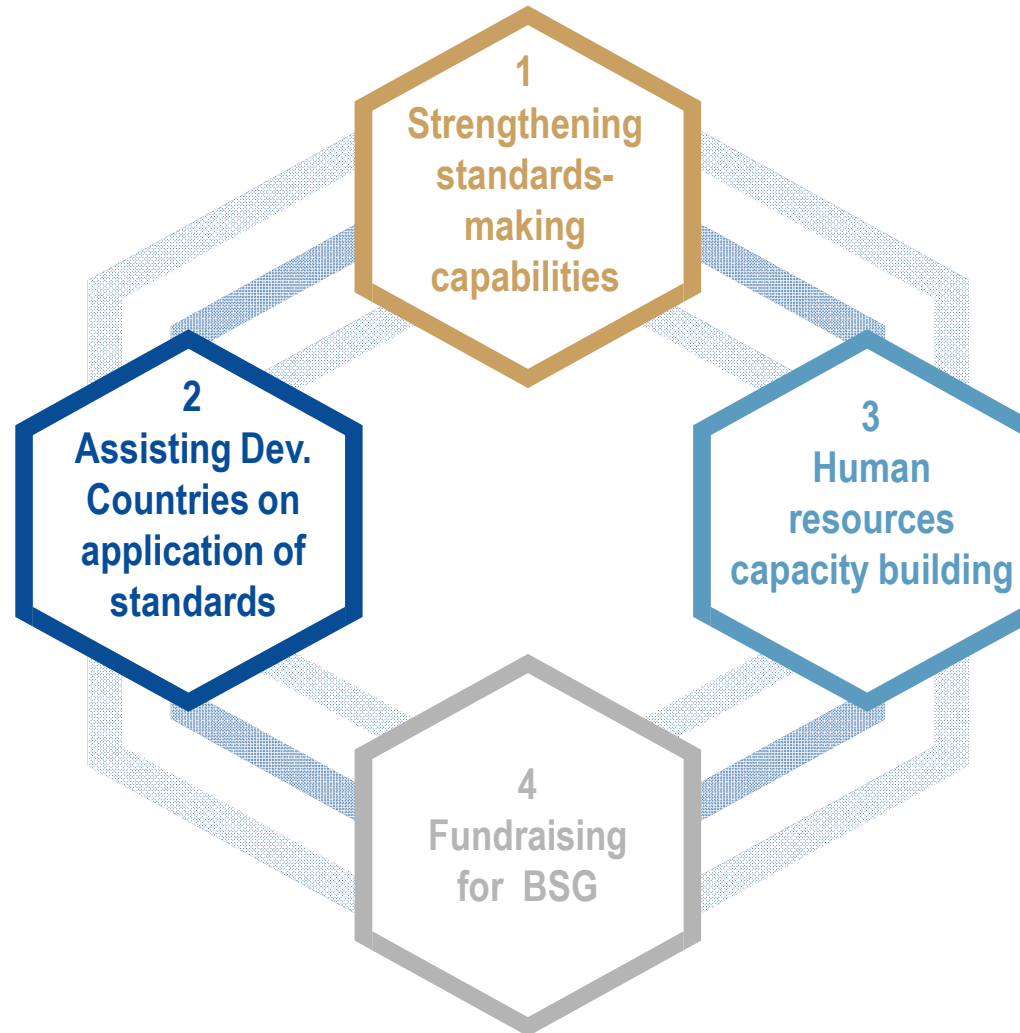

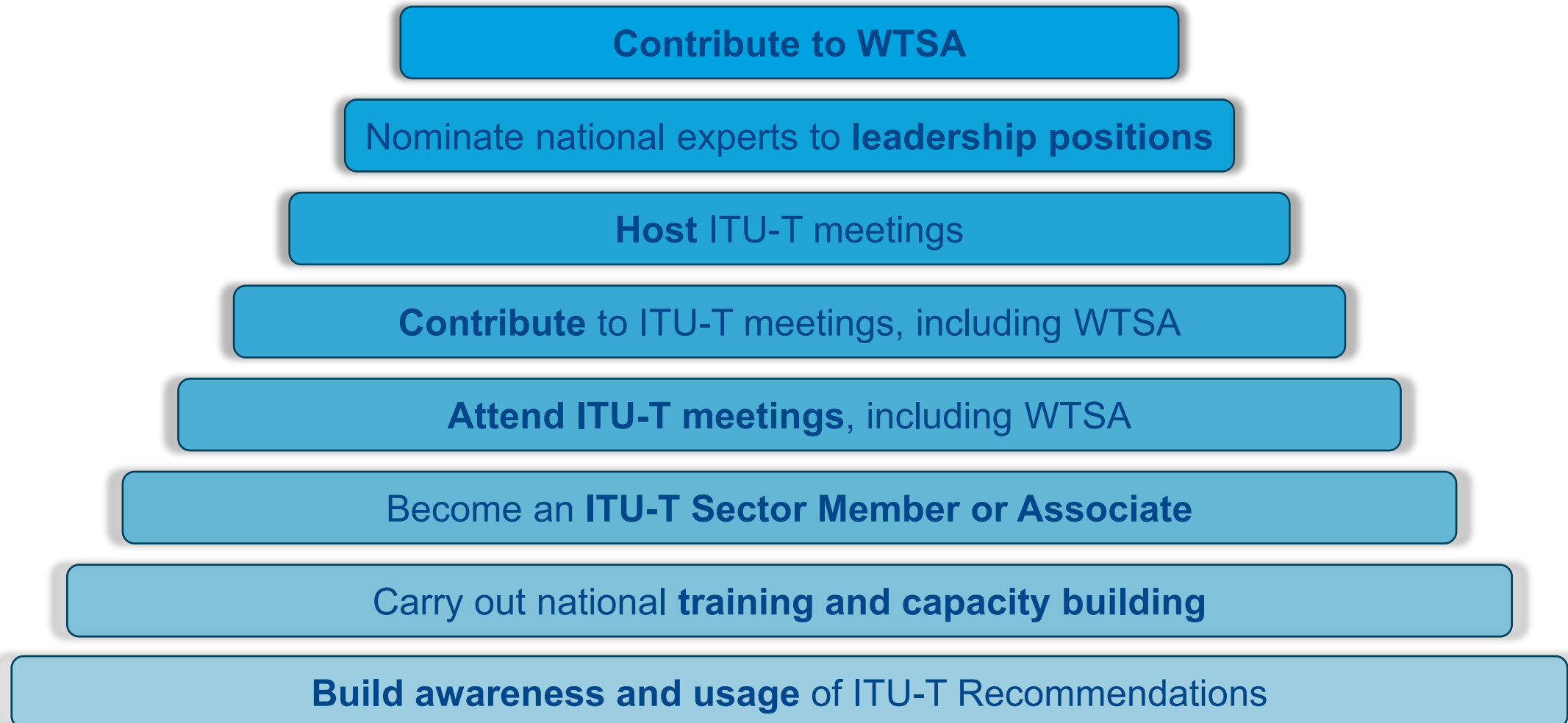
- **RESOLUTION 123 (Rev. Bucharest, 2022), *Bridging the standardization gap between developing and developed countries***
- ...close coordination mechanism among the three Sectors at the regional level for **bridging the digital divide**, through activities carried out by the **ITU regional offices**...;
- ...**assistance to enhance capacity building** in the standardization field, including through collaboration with the relevant academia, in close collaboration between ITU-T and **ITU-R**, and taking into consideration the activities carried out by the **ITU Academy** training centres and ... **BDT**;
- to identify ways and means to **support the participation of representatives of developing countries**, including prioritizing fellowships for those who submit contributions...;
- ..collaborate with the relevant **regional organizations** and support their work..;

Resources and partnerships

- **Resolution 44 - (Rev. New Delhi, 2022)** *Bridging the standardization gap between developing and developed countries*

Key changes:

1. Updated references to PP, WTSA and WTDC Resolutions, setting the context and establishing the need for collaboration.
2. Emphasis on the roles of Regional Telecommunication Organizations, ITU regional offices and ITU-T regional groups.
3. Training for thematic areas of emerging technologies/ICTs.
4. Enhance BSG/training resources, including face-to-face and online, and dependent on skill level; support mentorship (common ground with next generation and gender).
5. Raise awareness of standards and assist in implementation.

- **Our roles in bridging the standardization gap**

Collaboration between Members, Chairs, partners and ITU/TSB:

1. Encourage **engagement/participation** in training and standards-making.
2. Set **strategic objectives** (standardization ladder).
3. Effective use of **fellowships, remote participation, language services**.
4. Provide **funding** for regional initiatives.
5. **Host events** (online, in parallel with regional groups, stand-alone)
6. Use **mentoring** programmes, as appropriate.
