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### **Aging in the Americas**

of healthy

Currently, **14.6%** of inhabitants in the Region are 60+.

In 2025, persons 60+ will account for 18.6% of the total population of the Americas.

The population of people 60+ in LAC region is projected to increase **71%** by the year 2030...

...compared to the projected global increase of **56%**, and in the US alone, **1/5** people will be 65+ by 2030.

The highest levels of 60+ population are at **20%** in **Barbados**, **Canada**, **Cuba**, the **US**, and **Uruguay**, and the lowest at **5.9%** in **Belize**.

In Latin America and the Caribbean, demographic transition will take place in just 35 years, about half the time as that of other regions.

A child born in Brazil in 2015 can expect to live **20 years longer** than one born in the region just 50 years ago.

Healthy Aging: the process of developing and maintaining the functional ability that enables wellbeing in older age (WHO 2015)

# **Functional ability:** comprises the health-related attributes that enable people to be and to do what they value (WHO, 2015).





**Environment: where people** live their lives. Shape the things individuals with different levels of intrinsic capacity can do.

**FUNCTIONAL HABILITY:** integrates the INTRINSIC CAPACITY, the **ENVIRONMENT** where individuals live and the relationship between them



INTRINSIC **CAPACITY**: The sum of all mental and physical capacities a person has and can develop

### **Ageism and Technology**

- Digital divide between older and young generations
- Older adults who internalize the stereotype that older people cannot master technology may not even try to adopt new technologies
- Older adults are less included in focus groups assessing the design of new digital technologies

### **Environment and Technology**

Case Example from Chile: Strengthen the capacity of older people, communication and knowledge

- New app to inspire adaptation to their environment allows to report problems within the age friendly environment and communicate them to the municipality.
- Another app is to coordinate the network of age friendly cities with adults who are in extremely vulnerable situations, socially isolated, or in general for rural communities

- Access to technology, connection with older populations, and collaboration between local actors have been key actions that have had the greatest potential to mitigate the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic on older people
- A significant challenge noted by several municipalities is the lack of access to technology for older populations

- One-half of the global population is off-line
- Women and older persons experience digital inequity to a greater extent





### In the Region of the Americas...

- Information and communication technology has great potential for reducing social and economic inequalities that affect older adults, but can also exacerbate preexisting economic or social inequalities or even create new ones
- Available ICT statistics for Latin America show that the older adult age group is the most isolated from digital technologies, reflecting a deep digital age divide.
