Spain has been actively participating in all ITU activities related to Smart Cities since the beginning by Chairing the Focus Group on Smart and Sustainable Cities. We are committed to continuing our active involvement in ITU initiatives on Smart Cities through the Vicechairmanship of the recently established ITU-T Study Group 20 .

The upcoming study period for ITU-T Study Group 20 will deal with important state-of-the-art issues such as the work items proposed by Spain on a reference model for Smart Tourist Destinations, an Open Data Indicator in Smart Cites, as well as the requirements for deployment of smart services in rural communities.

Besides the standardization work of Study Group 20, Spain would like to contribute through its participation in SG20 Management Team to raise the visibility of the ITU work on Smart Cities both at national and international level.
