ITU-T SG2: Results

- Increased number of Associate Members (increased revenue for the Sector) (31 new Associates as of 2 October 2024)
- Diversity of requests for NNAI resources for other entities:
 - M2M IoT, Space
- Keeping pace with innovative developments (carrier switching)
- Developing the necessary Recommendations for management in new environments including:
 - requirements for management of blockchain systems, robot-based on-site smart patrol of telecommunication network, work order processing in telecom management & log analysis with AI, intelligence levels of AI enhanced telecom operation and management, and management interface specification methodology


Development of NNAI resources to meet evolving needs
