NATIONAL STRATEGY

- Internet safety for young people is addressed in the <u>Cyber Peace Initiative</u> of the Ministry of Communications and Information Technology.
- The <u>National e-Safety Working Group</u> started its activities in October 2009 with the aim of activating a national strategy for protecting and empowering children online.

UN CONVENTION

• Signed and ratified, with no declarations or reservations to articles 16, 17(e) and 34(c), the Convention on the Rights of Child.

UN PROTOCOL

Acceded, with no declarations or reservations to articles 2 and 3, to the <u>Optional Protocol to The</u>
 Convention on the Rights of the Child on the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution

and Child Pornography.

INSTITUTIONAL SUPPORT

- The Ministry of Communications and Information Technology provides information on <u>Internet</u> Safety (*).
- The Ministry of Communications and Information Technology provides information provides training opportunities and <u>information</u> (*) for parents under its Cyber Peace Initiative.
- <u>TEDate (*)</u> was established in 2001 by <u>Egypt Telecom (*)</u> and is Egypt's largest IP based data communications vehicle. Its service is supervised by the <u>National Telecommunication Regulatory Agency (NTRA).</u>
- TEData launched the "<u>Family Internet</u>" service to protect children from inappropriate content exposure on the web.
