NATIONAL LEGISLATION

- [Section 133\(e\) and 203A](#) from the Criminal Code – *does not explicitly criminalize child pornography but only indecent material.*
- The country proposed in April 2012 a Computer Crime and Cybercrime [Bill](#) with provision for child online protection.

UN CONVENTION

- Signed and ratified, with no declarations or reservations to articles 16, 17(e) and 34(c), the [Convention on the Rights of Child](#).

UN PROTOCOL

- Acceded, with no declarations or reservations to articles 2 and 3, the [Optional Protocol To The Convention on the Rights of the Child on the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution and Child Pornography](#).
