NATIONAL LEGISLATION

- <u>Section 351</u> of the Criminal Law Offences Act *does not explicitly criminalize child pornography but only indecent or obscene material.*
- Sections 11 to 13 and 21 of the Sexual Offences Act of 2010.

UN CONVENTION

• Signed and ratified, with no declarations or reservations to articles 16, 17(e) and 34(c), the Convention on the Rights of Child.

UN PROTOCOL

Acceded, with no declarations or reservations to articles 2 and 3, the <u>Optional Protocol to The</u>
 <u>Convention on the Rights of the Child on the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution</u>

and <u>Child Pornography</u>.
