NATIONAL LEGISLATION

• Sections 4-6 of the Child Trafficking and Pornography Act.

UN CONVENTION

• Signed and ratified, with no declarations or reservations to articles 16, 17(e) and 34(c), the Convention on the Rights of the Child.

UN PROTOCOL

• Signed but did not ratify, as of the 14th December 2012, the <u>Optional Protocol to The Convention</u> on the Rights of the Child on the Sale of Children, Child Prostitution and Child Pornography.
